

Neighborhood Planning Update

Baseline Masionization | Many residents in our District are concerned with the "mansionization" of single-story traditional houses. Last year, City Council took action to limit the scale of the construction and directed the Planning Department to revise the City's rules which govern the amount of residential floor area that can be developed on a single-family lot. The Planning Department recently released a draft of the ordinance. After considerable public comment and participation, it is clear that more must be done to protect residential neighborhoods.
