## **Rescission: Cahuenga Pass Zone Change**

On Friday, City Council took action on my motion to rescind a General Plan Amendment and zone change of two parcels in the Cahuenga Pass. The proposed 250-unit development sat right in the center of an environmentally significant wildlife corridor, adjacent to the two-lane Cahuenga Blvd and the already congested 101-freeway. Equally important, the proposed changes moved forward without community input. My office worked in lock-step with the affected community to ensure that all voices are heard. #### A Call to Action on Homelessness

On **Monday May 9th, 2016**, my office, along with a coalition of Valley Councilmembers, sent a <u>letter</u> to the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) and the City Administrative Officer, Miguel Santana, to push for much needed additional funding and resources to tackle the 35% increase in homelessness in the **San Fernando Valley**.



#### Silver Lake Reservoir

In the summer of 2015, the Silver Lake Reservoir was taken offline and drained for the installation of piping to connect to a replacement reservoir near Griffith Park. My office is working with Councilmember Mitch O'Farrell and LADWP to ensure we create a sustainable and environmentally conscious plan in refilling the reservoir. My office will continue to work directly with the community to ensure we build consensus on any proposed solution.
