Sir,

I herewith have the honor to hand you two publications of His Excellency the Governor of Curacao & its dependencies sub n<sup>o</sup> 2 & 3. - the one containing the introduction of the Regulation for the administration of the Government of Curacao and its dependencies, arrested by His Majesty's Resolue of the 24<sup>th</sup> January 1898 n<sup>o</sup> 51. and the other including certain stipulations to insure the execution of the said new Regulations, with request that you will have the same published without delay, to be put in force the day after.

I am informed by His Excellency the Governor of Curacao & its dependencies that in as much as no new organization relative to the functionaries of the Island under your command has been received it may be considered, at least until the further pleasure of the home Government in reference thereto, shall be ascertained, that no other alteration in the relation between that Island

tion, than that which emanates  
directly from the Regulations itself,  
and that you will therefore according  
to art. 30, assume the title of "Gerag.  
-hebber," and have an advising Committee

bers to me, in order to submit the  
same to His Excellency the Governor
