THE ABOVE SIGNALS WILL BE MADE BY A SIREN NEAR THE HOSPITAL AND WILL CONSIST OF RISING TONES RATHER THAN DISTINCT BLASTS COMPARED TO THE POWERHOUSE WHISTLES.

HARBOR GENERAL FIRE ALARM & DESIGNATION SIGNALS

ONE (1) LONG BLAST FOLLOWED BY FOUR (4) SHORT BLASTS ON THE ELECTRIC SIREN OR AIR WHISTLE, FOLLOWED BY CODE OF SIGNALS TO INDICATE LOCATION OF FIRE, REPEATED AT SHORT INTERVALS:

CRUDE PIER, #1 FINGER PIER

ONE SHORT

#2, #4 FINGER PIER, SHIPYARD

TWO SHORT

GASOLINE DOCKS #1 & #2, NEW BARGE DOCKS

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF THE TELEPHONE

DIAL TONE - THIS IS A STEADY BUZZ AND IS HEARD AFTER LIFTING THE HANDSET FROM ITS CRADLE AND BEFORE DIALING. IT INDICATES THAT THE PHONE IS READY FOR USE. WHEN NO TONE IS HEARD UPON LIFTING THE HANDSET, EITHER THE OTHER PARTY IS USING THE LINE, OR THE SECTION OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM WHICH CONTROLS YOUR OWN PHONE IS BUSY. HANG UP AND TRY AGAIN IN A FEW SECONDS.

BUSY SIGNAL - THIS IS AN INTERMITTENT BUZZ. WHEN HEARD AFTER DIALING IT MEANS THAT THE NUMBER BEING CALLED IS BUSY. HANG UP AND TRY AGAIN IN A SHORT TIME.

DIALING - PLACE FINGER (NOT PENCIL OR OTHER IMPLEMENTS) IN THE OPENING OVER THE FIRST DIGIT OF THE NUMBER BEING CALLED, TURN DIAL TO FINGER STOP AND THEN RELEASE; WAIT UNTIL DIAL TONE STOPS, THEN DIAL THE OTHER DIGITS OF THE NUMBER BEING CALLED IN THE SAME MANNER. CAUTION - DO NOT FORCE THE DIAL TO ITS RESTING POSITION, AS THE SATISFACTORY OPERATION OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM DEPENDS UPON THE CORRECT SPEED OF THE DIAL WHILE RETURNING TO THE REST POSITION.

SPEAKING - SPEAK DIRECTLY INTO THE TRANSMITTER WITH LIPS CLOSE TO THE MOUTHPIECE. USE ORDINARY TONE OF VOICE AND PRONOUNCE WORDS CLEARLY AND DISTINCTLY.

END OF CONVERSATION - AT THE END OF A CONVERSATION RETURN HANDSET TO ITS CRADLE. IF THE HANDSET IS NOT PROPERLY REPLACED, BOTH YOUR PHONE AND THE OTHER SUBSCRIBER'S PHONE WILL REMAIN OUT OF SERVICE.

WRONG NUMBERS - IF YOUR PHONE REPEATEDLY DIALS WRONG NUMBERS AND YOU HAVE FOLLOWED CORRECTLY THE INSTRUCTIONS ON DIALING, YOUR PHONE PROBABLY REQUIRES ADJUSTMENT. SEE INSTRUCTIONS FOR REQUESTING REPAIRS TO YOUR PHONE. WE REQUEST THE COOPERATION OF ALL TELEPHONE USERS IN THIS SERVICE, BECAUSE IT IS THE SUREST AND QUICKEST METHOD OF LOCATING INSTRUMENTS WITH DEFECTIVE DIALS.

## OVERSEAS TELEPHONE CALLS

### OUTGOING CALLS

- (1) TELEPHONE THE CABLE CLERK (NO. 3400) AND REQUEST THE DESIRED RADIO-TELEPHONE CONNECTION. GIVE THE CABLE CLERK YOUR NAME, PAYROLL NUMBER, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER.
- (2) THE CABLE CLERK WILL MAKE THE NECESSARY ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE RADIO STATION, THEN INFORM YOU WHEN TO EXPECT THE CONNECTION TO BE MADE.
- (3) YOU WILL BE EXPECTED TO BE AVAILABLE TO YOUR TELEPHONE DURING THE DESIGNATED PERIOD. WHEN THE RADIO CHANNEL IS AVAILABLE, YOU WILL BE CALLED BY THE GOVERNMENT RADIO STATION, AND THE CONNECTION WITH THE CALLED PARTY OVERSEAS WILL BE COMPLETED.

### INCOMING CALLS

- (1) THE RADIO STATION WILL INFORM THE CABLE CLERK THAT A DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL IS BEING CALLED.
- (2) THE CABLE CLERK WILL LOCATE THE CALLED PARTY AND REQUEST HIM TO STAND BY AT ANY SELECTED TELEPHONE.
- (3) THE CABLE CLERK WILL THEN ADVISE THE RADIO STATION AT WHAT TELEPHONE NUMBER THE DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL MAY BE REACHED.
- (4) THE RADIO STATION WILL CALL THE SELECTED TELEPHONE NUMBER AND COMPLETE THE OVERSEAS COMMUNICATION.

THE GOVERNMENT WILL BILL THE COMPANY FOR PERSONAL CALLS OF EMPLOYEES AND COLLECTION WILL BE MADE, AS AT PRESENT, BY PAYROLL DEDUCTION. NORMALLY THERE ARE NO CHARGES FOR INCOMING CALLS, BUT, IN THE EVENT THE CHARGES ARE REVERSED, THE CALLED PARTY WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE COMPANY IN THE SAME MANNER AS FOR OUTGOING CALLS.

THE OVERSEAS TELEPHONE BOOTH IN THE GENERAL OFFICE BUILDING WILL BE MAINTAINED FOR THE USE OF TRANSIENTS AND EMPLOYEES WHO DO NOT HAVE A RESIDENCE TELEPHONE, OR FOR BUSINESS CALLS WHERE MORE CONVENIENT.



## REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

MAINTENANCE REPAIRS TO OR REPLACEMENTS OF DEFECTIVE TELEPHONES, WIRING OR ASSOCIATED SIGNALS OR OTHER EQUIPMENT FOR OFFICE TELEPHONES WILL BE HANDLED BY THE TELEPHONE EXCHANGE. ANYONE REQUIRING REPAIR SERVICE WILL USE ANOTHER PHONE AND DIAL THE PROPER NUMBER AS INDICATED BELOW AND REPORT THE TROUBLE.

TO MAKE A CALL TO SAN NICHOLAS OR ORANJESTAD, LIFT HANDSET, AWAIT DIAL TONE AND DIAL "0". AFTER A SHORT INTERVAL DIAL TONE WILL BE HEARD FROM THE SAN NICHOLAS EXCHANGE. DIAL THE NUMBER DESIRED, WHETHER IT BE IN SAN NICHOLAS OR ORANJESTAD.

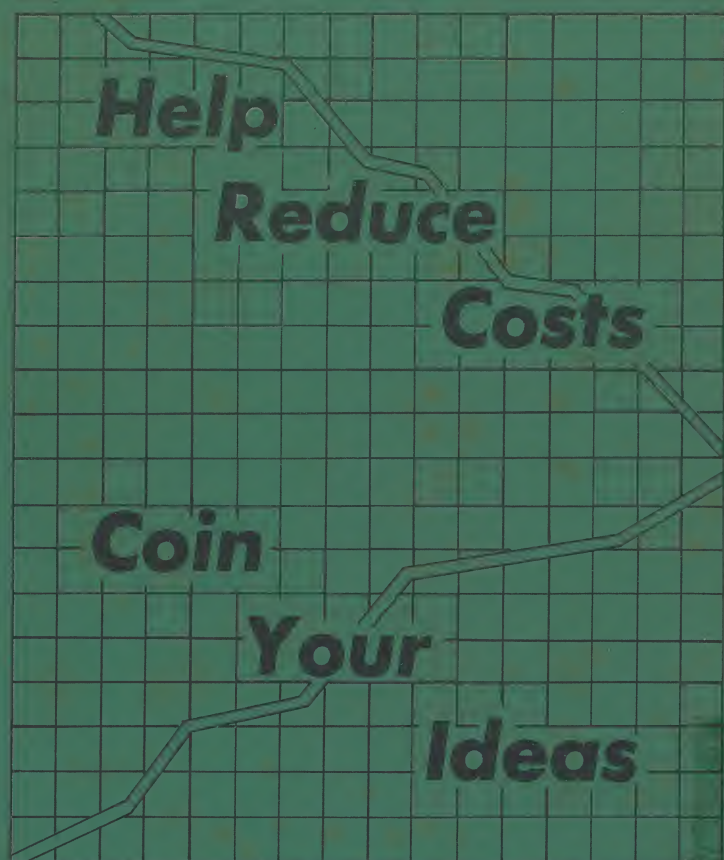
