

LAGO EMPLOYEES GET OFF WITH PAY ON CARNIVAL MONDAY

Under Article XVI, Section 6 g (1) of the Collective Working Agreement, all covered regular day workers will be off with pay on Carnival Monday, February 22. If a regular day worker is required to work on this day, he will be paid at his regular rate and will have one day added to his vacation accrual. Shift workers who cannot be spared from their jobs will have one day added to their vacation accrual.

All covered workers, both regular day and shift, who are absent for bona fide reasons (vacation, TIQ, etc.) on this day will have one day added to their vacation accrual.

FEBRUARY 23 PAYDAY ADVANCED TO FEBRUARY 19

At the request of the IOWUA, and in connection with the Carnival celebrations, Management has agreed to advance the February 23 payday to February 19.

The paybooths at the gates will be manned at 3 p.m. on the 19th for the convenience of employees on the day shift and those working 4-12.

The payroll could not be made ready in time to pay those employees working the 12-8 shift at 8 a.m. However these employees can collect their pay between 3 and 4:30 p.m. at the regular booths at the gates on February 19, or can do so at the Cashier's Office, G.O.B., on February 23. Those employees who normally receive their pay at the banks will be able to do so as scheduled on the 19th.
