QUEEN ELIZABETH 2 RECEIVES RECORD LOAD AT ORANJESTAD BUNKERING TERMINAL

Queen Elizabeth 2, one of the largest luxury ships in the world, received 4,520.89 long tons of bunker "C" fuel to establish an all-time record for Oranjestad yesterday. To accomplish this delivery, it took two shifts, two pumps, a parallel piping system and 10½ hours (starting time 8:12 a.m. - finishing time 6:30 p.m.). Assisting with engineering were Lago process engineers Alex Hoo and Roy Bergen. Supervising the operation was Marketing operations supervisor A. Thijsen.
