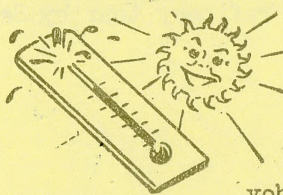
TOREN DEN CENTER NA TAR PLANT BEK DEN SERVICIO

DAKOTA TA GANA CAMPEONATO DI FUTBOL

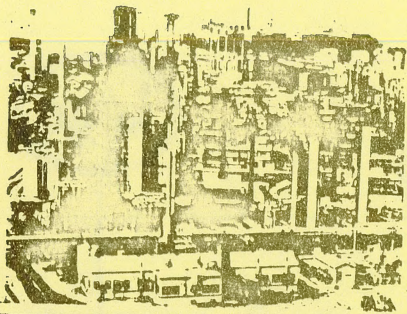

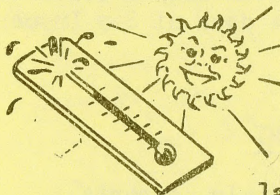
MIDDLE TOWER AT TAR PLANT IN SERVICE
