
## CARLOS BISLIP ELIGI PRESIDENT DI UNION PAN AMERICANO DI JUDO




## CARLOS BISLIP ELECTED PRESIDENT OF PAN AMERICAN JUDO UNION

## HURRICANE REPORT



The tropical storm which passed 10 miles north of Aruba about 11 a.m. yesterday, became a hurricane and was named Edith. At 6 a.m. today, she was reportedly becoming a minimal hurricane after gradually gaining strength during the night. Her center is estimated at latitude  $13.6^{\circ}$  North and longitude  $74.2^{\circ}$  West or 340 miles south-southeast of Kingston, Jamaica. She is moving West-Northwest at about 15 miles per hour, and is expected to turn more towards the Northwest at a slightly slower speed during the next 12 to 24 hours. Highest winds are estimated at 75 mph near the center and gales out 125 miles to the North and 50 miles to the South.
