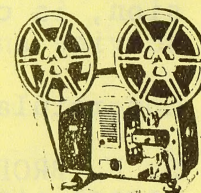

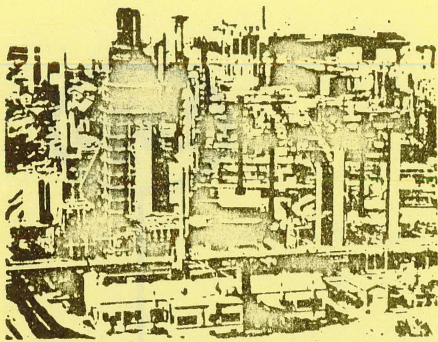

ORGANIZATION CHANGES ANNOUNCED IN TECHNICAL DEPARTMENT

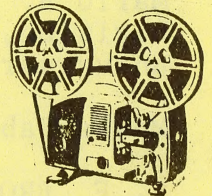

RAINFALL REPORT

The pluviometer at the Laboratories registered .960 inch of rainfall last week. During a similar period last year, .930 inch of rainfall was recorded. Rainfall for October measured 1.990 inches, compared with 2.730 inches in October 1970.
