Marc Anthony to headline Aruba International Film Festival Concert Series

ORANJESTAD – Award winning singer, songwriter, actor and producer Marc Anthony will headline the Aruba International Film Festival (AIFF) Concert Series on Saturday, June 23, 2012 at the AIFF Concert Plaza. The 3rd annual festival takes place June 22-28. The announcement was made today by AIFF Founder and executive producer Jonathan Vieira.

The AIFF Concert Series, a new component of the Film Festival, will also showcase the talented international music superstar DJ/Artist/Producer Chuckie who will be performing on the evening of Sunday, June 24th with his world touring brand Dirty Dutch, featuring many international performing DJs. The event will mark the first performance to be held on the beautiful AIFF Concert Plaza, located along the Oranjestad Harbor.

Marc Anthony has sold over 11 million albums worldwide and is considered one of the most influential artists of his time; a true ambassador of Latin music and culture. He has earned countless Standard gold and platinum certifications from the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA). The list of Grammy accolades began with a 1998 Grammy for Best Latin/Tropical Performance for "Contra La Corriente," followed with a 1999 Grammy for Song of the Year for "Dimelo

Driven in part by the crossover success of his smash single "I Need to Know (Dimelo)," "Marc Anthony," his English language debut album, helped usher in 1999's Latin pop explosion, and went on to achieve triple platinum status in the U.S. In 2005, Anthony went home double fisted



with a Grammy for Best Latin Pop Album of the Year for "Amar Sin Mentiras" and another Grammy for Best Tropical Album of the Year for "Valio la Pena." He has won a total of 18 "Premio lo Nuestro" Awards throughout his career, the most won by any artist. His influence was significantly recognized when he was included in the Top 10 List of influential New Yorkers compiled by New York Magazine.

Anthony has also established a highly credible acting résumé and may be seen in Academy Award® winning director Martin Scorsese's "Bringing Out the Dead" (1999); opposite Selma Hayak

in the Showtime original film, "In the Time of the Butterflies" (2001); and appears with Academy Award® winning actors Denzel Washington and Christopher Walken in director Tony Scott's "Man On Fire" (2004). Anthony also appeared in the 1997 Paul Simon musical, "The Capeman." Anthony starred as the Puerto Rican salsa pioneer Héctor Lavoe, with Jennifer Lopez as Puchi, in the biopic, "El Cantante," directed by Leon Ichaso. Anthony also appeared on the small screen as Nick Renata on TNT's "Hawthorne" TV series with Jada Pinkett Smith.

Insider insights: Space Shuttle Discovery finds a new home

NASA personnel have experienced some bittersweet events over the last three years with the retirement of the shuttle program and final missions to the Hubble Space Telescope and the International Space Station. Aruba has been fortunate to have a front row seat and some insider insights into these events as native son Dr. Ed Cheung has shared his eyewitness accounts with readers of THE MORNING NEWS.

Dr. Cheung joined the NASA team in the early 1990's

immediately upon attaining his doctorate in Electrical Engineering, specializing in Robotics, from Yale, through a scholarship from NASA and Phillips Electronics. He rose through the ranks to become the Principal Engineer of the Hubble Space Telescope Service Project, devising with his team innovative equipment for not only the maintenance of the HST, but cutting edge technology such as the Wide Field Camera 3, which was installed on the last mission to the HST.

in 2009; it is providing scientists with information and images of deep space never seen before.

It was his ASCS/NCS Relay Unit Breaker Assembly or ARUBA box, created in record time, which was installed on the HST during an emergency mission in 2002 that repaired a faulty cooling system and stopped the telescope from falling out of orbit.

Dr. Cheung was an active participate in the final flights of shuttles Endeavor and Discovery, ST-135, on duty in the "Tweet Tent" at Kennedy Space Center, explaining events to onlookers.

Dr. Cheung also participated in the placement of Discovery at the Smithsonian on April 20 as one of the NASA scientists explaining the space program and the HST to enthu-

siastically fascinated youngsters and their parents.

"The list of missions that Discovery has completed is impressive. Among those is of course the launch of the Hubble Space Telescope. It is for this reason that the Smithsonian requested this Shuttle in particular when they were announced for retirement," he informs THE MORNING NEWS.

"NASA announced that Discovery would be arriving in the DC area on 4/17/2012, and that it would be flying low to allow a good view by the public. We had initially intended to see the flight at Dulles, where it would land, but then it was announced there would be a flyover at NASA/Goddard. No doubt this special pass was a tribute to the many payloads that were built here. We decided to see the pass with our friends and coworkers at Goddard. Shuttle Discovery was mounted piggyback on a specially outfitted Boeing 747 at Kennedy Space Center for its final trip to Washington, D.C.

"After the flyover, the Shuttle Carrier Aircraft landed at Dulles International, and they taxied to an area where Discovery was lifted off from the carrier. Two days later, a ceremony was scheduled where she would arrive at the Udvar-Hazy Smithsonian Annex (UH). By then, the Shuttle Enterprise (which has only flown in atmosphere during a glide test), had been pulled out, and was awaiting the arrival of her big sister.'

At the start of the ceremony, Discovery was partially hidden behind some trees. To simulate landing, they then played the sound that is so familiar to Shuttle watchers during a landing: the double BOOM-BOOM of a sonic boom to announce the arrival of Discovery; she was then stately stowed into place for us to see. It was an historic moment; two shuttles, nose to nose, in one shot."

The NASA scientists were invited to sign a banner greeting Discovery, Dr. Cheung added his unique signature, which he also placed on an inside bulkhead, when Discovery returned from its final mission. For three days, during the placement of Discovery at the Smithsonian, a number of NASA departments performed outreach programs, explaining their purpose and achievements to delighted audiences. They met famous astronauts, such as John Grunsfeld, who is now Astronaut and Science Mission Directorate Chief, and the man who actually placed the ARUBA box on the Hubble in 2002.

Dr. Cheung was there enlightening visitors about the HST program, and the technology his team has perfected that will robotically repair and refuel satellites in orbit, thus

doubling their life span and use, allowing to cut costs dra-

matically. Of this final mission with the shuttles, his feeling and comments reflect those of many of his colleagues who, like him, chose to stay on with NASA if possible and continue research, rather than move into the private sector, which would have been more lucrative. "It was quite sad to see the Shuttle Carrier take off and leave the ground at Kennedy," he concluded. "The majesty and gravity of the situation made me quite emotional. I will miss the Shuttle fleet. As I wrote on my blog, they have brought me many good things, and it was an exciting privilege to have payloads on them."

Dutch parliament reaches austerity deal

PARIS - The Dutch parliament on Thursday reached agreement on an austerity programme demanded by the EU, parliamentary group leaders said, days after the government collapsed over the measures.

"We have reached an agreement," Stef Blok, head of the liberal VVD group, the party of outgoing Prime Minister Mark Rutte, told parliament.

Blok said five political parties from across a wide political spectrum had reached the deal and a vote on the austerity law set for later in the evening should be a formality.

"It now seems possible that the Netherlands will send a letter tonight to Brussels," said Sybrand van Haersma Buma, head of the Christian Democrat group, just before a debate on the austerity measures.

Rutte's outgoing government lost its functioning majority in the Dutch lower house after Geert Wilders, the leader of the far-right Freedom Party, pulled away his support for austerity cuts needed to meet European Union deficit rules.

Although not part of Rutte's coalition, the Freedom Party had been an ally in parliament and thus ensured the government's survival.

The law is to include measures to reduce the country's

public deficit, which reached 4.7 percent last year, to within the EU ceiling of 3.0 percent of gross domestic product.

In addition to Rutte's VVD and the Christian Democrats, the bill is supported by centrists of the D66, an environmentalist party and the Christian party ChristenUnie.

The five parties, representing 77 seats in the 150-seat house, agreed on measures that include a sales tax hike, health care cuts and a pay freeze for civil servants, Dutch media said.

Prime Minister Mark Rutte has called the agreement "a fantastic result". During yesterday evening's parliamentary debate, he complimented Finance Minister Jan Kees de Jager and the five parliamentary parties who brokered the deal.

Prime Minister Rutte pointed out that much of the package had been negotiated during seven weeks of negotiations in his official residence, the Catshuis. However at the last minute Freedom Party leader Geert Wilders pulled out. The cabinet was left with no choice and Mr Rutte handed in the government's resignation to Queen Beatrix.

Meanwhile three parliamentary parties – known as the Kunduz Three because they helped the minority coalition out before over a police

training mission in the Afghan province of Kunduz – indicated they were willing to try to thrash out a deal in just a couple of days.

US seizes websites in stolen credit card crackdown

WASHINGTON (AFP) - US authorities have ordered the seizure of 36 websites engaged in selling and distributing stolen credit card numbers, officials said Thursday

Visitors to the website, now in the custody of the federal government, are now greeted by a seizure banner under the FBI and Justice Department operation run in coordination with Britain's Serious Organised Crime Agency (SOCA) and other international law enforcement agencies.

Under Operation Wreaking hAVoC, law enforcement officials made undercover purchases of credit card numbers, at the suspect websites.

The sites are known as Automated Vending Carts, (AVC) which allow visitors to purchase stolen credit card numbers online using a virtual "shopping cart."

The banks that issued the credit card numbers, including Bank of America, Sun Trust and Capital One, confirmed that the websites were not authorized to sell the numbers. Authorities obtained seizures orders from a federal magistrate judge in the Eastern District of Virginia.

Fakes worth millions sized in Interpol-led raids in Americas

LYON (AFP) - An Interpol-led sting led to the seizure of nearly \$30 million worth of counterfeit goods in 11 countries in North and South America, the Lyon-based organisation said on Thursday.

About 200 people were arrested in the raids. The goods ranged from toys and cigarettes to engine oil and computer material.

Operation Maya, which ran from March 1 to 15, revealed "increasingly elaborate efforts by criminals to avoid detection," a statement said.

It said items were "smuggled into a country via one route while counterfeit trade mark materials including stickers for computers, batteries, mobile phones and even car emblems, were sent separately to be used later to 'brand' the products."

"Operation Maya again shows that there is no product which is not being counterfeited and criminals are using every means available to traffic fake and illicit goods," said its project manager, Roberto Manriquez.

The raids were conducted in the United States, Canada, Colombia, Mexico, Belize, Costa Rica, Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama.

Operation Maya was launched with the support of the US Department of Justice and US Patent and Trademark Office.

It was based on Interpol's Operation Jupiter model which, since its launch in 2004, has led to more than 1,660 arrests and the seizure of more than 12 million fake goods worth more than \$500 million (377 million euros).

Meanwhile in Miami US Customs and Border Protection on Wednesday announced the capture of two high-speed boats in the Caribbean loaded with more than 4,840 pounds (2,200 kilograms) of cocaine worth more than \$362 million.

A Florida-based P-3 reconnaissance plane detected the two vessels on April 20 some 120 miles (190 kilometers) off the east coast of Panama and notified local authorities, who chased the two boats.

"One vessel abandoned the contraband before arriving on shore, while the second go-fast (vessel) was seized nearby," the border patrol said.



International community hails Taylor conviction



LONDON (AFP) - The international community roundly cheered yesterday's conviction of former Liberian president Charles Taylor as a historic precedent that paves the way for future trials against criminal heads of state.

Britain's Foreign Secretary William Hague said Taylor's conviction on charges of arming Sierra Leonean rebels in a brutal civil war was proof that national leaders could not hide behind immunity.

"Those who have committed the most serious of crimes can and will be held to account for their actions." Hague said

for their actions," Hague said.

Taylor is expected to be jailed in Britain after he is sentenced May 30, ending five years of hearings at the UNbacked Special Court for Sierra Leone.

UN High Commissioner for Human Rights Navi Pillay said the "historic moment in the development of international justice" meant tyrannical rulers could no longer retire on blood money, while Washington said the conviction was an "enormous" historical milestone.

"The Taylor prosecution at the Special Court delivers a strong message to all perpetrators of atrocities, including those in the highest positions of power, that they will be held accountable," the US State Department said.

The view was echoed by EU foreign policy chief Catherine Ashton, who called the judgment a major achievement that "represents a land-

mark decision in the fight against impunity."

Taylor's lawyer Courtenay Griffiths, however, slammed the decision and accused the prosecution of "buying" evidence.

Interpol said the conviction was a milestone and pledged to "continue to work closely with all international tribunals to identify, locate and bring to justice those individuals accused of war crimes."

In Sierra Leone, which underwent a horrific 11-year conflict that claimed 120,000 lives, victims watched on monitors as the verdict unfolded in a Dutch courtroom.

"I am happy ... I feel justice has been done," said Al Hadji Jusu Jarka, whose arms were hacked off in 1999. Others greeted the news with quiet relief and sombre reflection as the verdict stirred deeply traumatic memories of the horrors inflicted during the civil war, in which rebel groups fought over access to Sierra Leone's diamonds.

Prosecutors said the Revolutionary United Front bought weapons from Taylor, paying him with illegally mined "blood diamonds" worth millions, stuffed into mayonnaise jars. The rebel group used slave labour to gather the gems and enlisted child soldiers.

Amnesty International and Human Rights Watch said the verdict sent a message to highranking officials responsible for crimes that they would eventually face justice.

Brazil to boost military presence to protect Amazon wealth

BRASILIA (AFP) - Brazil will boost its military presence in the Amazon region to protect its huge natural resources from any external threat, Defense Minister Celso Amorim told the Senate Thursday.

"The commitment to the defense of the Amazon is fundamental. Navy, Air Force, all services will boost their presence in the Amazon in the next few years," he said without giving further details.

Amorim said Brazil did not feel threatened by any neighboring country but added: "We cannot rule out that some power from outside the region" may covet the natural resources of the Amazon, the planet's largest rainforest and its main source of fresh water.

"We are working on a plan to deploy (security) forces and the Amazon plays a very important role. It's the most vulnerable part of our country," Amorim said. "We have a wealth of resources which can make us the target of adventures," he added.

Amorim said the country's strategic planners were planning to boost "transparent cooperation" with other Amazon countries, referring to plans to set up a security commission with Peru and Colombia.

"We do not feel threatened by any South American countries and we do not want anyone to feel threatened by us. We always want full transparency to avoid suspicions," the minister said.

Brazil, Latin America's largest country and the world's sixth largest economy, shares the sprawling Amazon with Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, Suriname and Venezuela.

Brasilia is also boosting its naval power in the South Atlantic with a ambitious submarine program to protect its huge deep-water oil reserves and project its growing influence.

Under the National Defense Strategy unveiled in 2008, the navy was tasked with developing a blue-water force to protect Brazil's huge sub-salt oil reserves, the Amazon river basin and its 7,491 km (4,655 miles) coastline.

The sub-salt oil fields, located off the country's southeast Atlantic coast beneath kilometers of ocean, bedrock and hot sat-beds, could contain more than 100 billion barrels of high-quality recoverable oil, according to official estimates

The centerpiece of the naval buildup is the ProSub program under which France is to supply four Scorpene-class dieselelectric submarines and help develop the non-nuclear components of Brazil's first nuclear-powered fast attack submarine.

In Vegas, a new cure for monster hangovers



LAS VEGAS (AFP) - It's Sunday lunchtime in Las Vegas and Justin looks like he wants to curl up and die. He has a monster hangover after drinking for two days solid. But help, he hopes, is at hand.

The 38-year-old from Seattle is among the first customers trying out a new service, "Hangover Heaven", which promises to "cure" his throbbing head, sweaty pallor and general feeling of death, all within 45 minutes.

Justin -- who asks sheepishly not to give his surname was speaking on board the shiny blue-and-white "Hangover Heaven" bus, parked outside the Mandalay Bay casino on the southern end of the infamous Vegas Strip. From the outside it looks like any other tour bus. Inside, the vehicle is rigged out not unlike an ambulance: IV tubes, pulsometers, attentive nurses, and, if it all gets too much, soothing, darkened bunks.

The trained anesthesiologist -- who still works in hospitals locally in his "day job" -- came up with the idea while working with patients in recovery rooms, after qualifying in 2001.

"Watching patients in the post-anesthesia care unit, I noticed they had a lot of the same symptoms that people with a hangover have: the nausea, the headache, aches and pains, disoriented feeling.

And I thought maybe these medications that I'm using to

treat them in the recovery room could work for a hangover," he said.

Happily for him, he lives in the Nevada gambling capital internationally renowned as a center for heavy partying and intoxication of all kinds, and, of course, the setting for the first of the blockbuster "Hangover" movies

What's more, "when people come to Vegas and drink, they're much more prone to get a hangover because of the time span over which they drink, it's much longer and they get more dehydrated because they're in the desert.

"So it's the perfect set-up for hangovers," he said.

The service offers to "cure" shell-shocked morning-after revelers of their hangover using.

All of this care does not come cheap: there are two basic packages, "Redemption" and "Salvation", offered at the introductory prices of \$90 and \$150 respectively.

Both provide drugs by IV, but the premium option includes intravenous hydration, anti-nausea and anti-inflammatory medications, as well as vitamin supplements, which can "remain in your system for days after the therapy."

China commits \$10.5 bn for business in ex-communist Europe

WARSAW (AFP) - Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao yesterday unveiled a total of \$10.5 billion dollars in credit lines and funds aimed at boosting business with the blossoming economies of central and eastern Europe.

On his first visit to Poland in a quarter century, Premier Wen announced a \$10 billion (7.57 billion euros) special credit line to support joint projects in the ex-communist region.

The Chinese leader, who is winding up a four-nation European tour after earlier stops in Iceland, Germany and Sweden, also announced plans for a \$500 million start-up fund backing Chinese business ventures in central and eastern Europe.

The new strategy suggests a major departure from the modest \$821 million China sank into the region between 2004-10, according to recent data by the Central & Eastern Europe Development Institute (CEED).

Analysts insist the cash-rich Chinese are keen to capitalise on the region's stability, growth and competitive prices to gain "perfect access to the West European market" -- still Beijing's top export destination.

Germany's Merkel rules out reopening EU fiscal pact

BERLIN (AFP) - German Chancellor Angela Merkel yesterday repeated her opposition to revisit an EU fiscal pact despite growing calls that leaders privilege growth in the eurozone instead of just austerity.

The treaty, signed by 25 of the 27 European Union member nations, "is not renegotiable", Merkel told the WAZ regional news group.

As to "the challenge of growth, it has long been the second pillar of our policy alongside sound public finances", Merkel said.

Merkel was referring to calls by the French presidential candidate Francois Hollande for Europe to seek growth instead of just austerity in order to end the debt crisis that has plagued the eurozone for the past two years.

The Socialist frontrunner's call for the EU fiscal pact to be renegotiated to include ways to boost growth had been derided by his opponent President Nicolas Sarkozy as naive and dangerous, and a breach of France's word to its partners

But on Wednesday, European Central Bank governor Mario Draghi called for

growth initiatives and Merkel had conceded that new measures were needed, although neither shifted in their support for the pact.

Merkel, of Germany's centre-right Christian Democrats, said she supported Sarkozy in the election because of their ideological closeness and because of the work carried out together "for the good of Europe" throughout the crisis.

But Merkel also told WAZ that solid ties between France and Germany would continue no matter what because the remaining contenders in the French run-off election on May 6 were both "pro-European".

Safety Tips from the Police for Motorbike Users





ORANJESTAD -- In view of the recent Motorbike fatal accidents, the Police Force has issued re-minders regarding the law with respect to the security of operating motorbikes.

The recent fatalities has brought much suffering to the families and to others involved in the process of the incident as well as to the community in general. Hence, it is imperative that the Police Force remind us all of the importance of obeying the laws. The traffic laws are designed to protect our community of dangers, both physical danger and from damage to material. One of those exposed to more danger than any other is the operator of a motorbike. Of late, many have chosen to operate a motorbike, or ATV (the so-called Quad Racers) and scooters. Some use these for pleasure, while there are those who use the motorbike to save money on gas. Still others use the motorbike to help protect the environment from more pollutants.

For whatever reason you are operating a motorbike, the fact is that there are many more two-wheeled vehicles on our public roads today.

The Police Force wants to remind us all that, if you operate a two-wheeled vehicle (motorbike):

- 1. the law (article 47 of the traffic law) says that you must wear a helmet for your own safety. This helm must also be one that fits properly on your head to offer adequate protection.
- 2. The helm must be properly secured on your head with a band under your chin. Hence it can not simply be resting on your head. It must be properly fastened.
- 3. This same law also states that the helm must be made of a durable material which can truly protect you head in the event of an accident. A full-faced helmet is advisable to better protect both your head and face. A good helm will protect your head in any acci-

dent situation.

4. Although not included in the law, but appropriate clothing is also necessary when operating a motorbike. If you can afford it, a good motorbike suit is highly recommended. If not, your clothing should be of such that help protect you against sever scratches if you fall on asphalt. Clothing with sponge filling will help lessen the impact of a fall. Leather boots are also preferable. Never barefoot, or with slippers, or in shorts. Raw back is worse than anything imaginable.

5. Operating a motorbike at night, the following is very important: Wear clothing of clear colors easily visible at night. White, neon yellow, neon orange and reflective material are always best. It is also advisable to affix reflective material on the bike. Place such material on the sides of the bike as well, so that should you fall off the bike at night other traffic will be able to see you and summons help.


6. Be sure that your tires are properly inflated and are in good condition.

- 7. Make every effort to avoid driving on wet roads. Eleven the manufactures of motorbikes advise against operating these bikes on wet surfaces. If you must travel on wet roads, use a dirt surface or rough soil or road with less traffic and maintain a speed of no more than 50km/per hour.
- 8. By all means, never use a cellular while driving your motorbike! Switch off your cell or simply ignore any calls coming in while you're operating a motorbike.
- 9. Never use drugs or alcohol if you have to operate a motor vehicle, and this includes a motorbike!

10. Use extra caution when overtaking vehicles on the road, this is especially for vehicles in a traffic line up. Many accidents have occurred when overtaking vehicle in a line up. A door may suddenly open on you, or a vehicle may decide suddenly to jump out of line not realizing that you are approaching.

Each of these rules has one objective, and that is to protect you. But, if you fail to obey the rules you will suffer the ugly and painful consequences. The Police Force, therefore urges everyone to make a commitment to follow the rules for their own safety and for the safety of others.

Also, those with larger vehicles on our roads must be considerate of others, of motorbikes. Operators of automobiles need to be more respectful to motorbikes.



Secret Service probes El Salvador prostitution claims

WASHINGTON (AFP) - The Secret Service told US law-makers Thursday it is investigating new accusations of misconduct in El Salvador, where agents of a presidential advance team reportedly partied at a strip club and paid for sex.

"Earlier this week the US Secret Service received a call concerning the allegations," the elite presidential protection force said in a memo to lawmakers, a congressional source told AFP.

The explosive new allegations -- on the heels of the Colombia sex scandal that saw eight agents dismissed from the service and prompted a sweeping investigation -- were first reported Thursday by KIRO-TV.

It said a subcontractor "who worked extensively with the Secret Service advance team" was with the agents and some military specialists at a San Salvador strip club days before President Barack Obama's trip to the country in March 2011.

The subcontractor told KIRO he witnessed agents drinking heavily and that several of them paid for sexual favors from women in a VIP section of the club.

The Secret Service said in its note to lawmakers that it was seeking to interview the investigative reporter "in attempt to get any and all information he may have in an effort to verify the allegations," the congressional source said.





SAN FRANCISCO (AFP) -The fourth-most entrants in US Open history, a total of 9,006 golfers, have been accepted for the 2012 tournament qualifying, the US Golf Association (USGA) announced on Thursday.

Tiger Woods, defending champion Rory McIlroy of Northern Ireland and English stars Luke Donald and Lee Westwood are among 53 golfers who are automatically qualified for the year's second major June 14-17 at The Olympic Club in San Francisco.

Also included on that list are South Koreans K.J. Choi and Yang Yong-Eun, Masters winner Bubba Watson, US star Phil Mickelson, South Africa's Louis Oosthuizen and Aus-

"It's always gratifying to see how many golfers from across the world are interested in playing," USGA executive director Mike Davis said.

Local 18-hole qualifying events will be played at 109 sites from April 30 to May 17, leading to sectional qualifying over 36 holes on May 21 in Japan, May 28 in England and June 4 at 11 US courses.

Applications were taken only through the internet, with 677 taken last Wednesday, the final day to apply, and 124 of those coming in the final hour, the last being US pro Brad Doster just 29 seconds before the deadline.

Jason May, a 38-year-old amateur from Michigan, was the first entrant on March 5.

Golf: More than 9,000 enter NBA: Bryant to sit, hand Durant scoring title

LOS ANGELES (AFP) - Kobe Bryant will sit out the Los Angeles Lakers' last game of the NBA regular season in Sacramento on Thursday, ensuring Oklahoma City's Kevin Durant the league's scoring title.

Bryant would have needed to score 38 points to deny Durant a third straight scoring

But with the contest meaningless as far as playoff position, and the Lakers due to open their post-season campaign on Sunday against either Dallas or Denver, coach Mike Brown said Thursday his superstar would sit out, according to a tweet from Sports Illustrated's Sam Amick.

While reaction from Lakers fans was swift and disappointed, Bryant had already said he was more concerned with maximizing the Lakers' playoff prospects.

The Lakers clinched the Pacific Division and third seed in the Western Conference when the Clippers lost at Atlanta on Tuesday.

Durant scored 32 points in the Thunder's 106-101 loss to Denver on Wednesday, Oklahoma City's final game of the

regular season. He finished the regular season averaging 28.0 points per game.

Bryant is averaging 27.9 points per game.
