






San Nicolas Live Longer With Fresh Seafood Secret





To remove the words; crazy, weird, strange and others, and replace them with unique,



San Nicolas Business Association meets Three River Estate Developers..

San Nicolas, Aruba. Last Wednesday, June 26th the board of the SNBA met with the developers of the Future Baby Beach Hotel by an invitation extended from the Minister of Infrastructure and Environment, Mr. Otmar Oduber, at the historical monument the Nicolaas Store in very heart of San Nicolas. Also present was the director of the DIP (department of Infrastructure) and other department officials.

It was a meet and greet opportunity conbined with a presentation by the hotel developers and management team. The presentation was quite extensive and we learned the hotel will consist of 900 rooms total, phase one(1) will consist of 600 rooms dedicated to couples, and the 2nd phase dedicated to family. A total 3 restaurants, two huge infinity pools, a complete gym and a 4000m2

conference room. The architecture would reflect the environment with some spectacular views of the baby beach, all to be constructed on the clip.



The minister and the developer promised that there would be no shopping facilities on the hotel

premises and idea was to motivate the guests to dine around and shop in San Nicolas. The board of the SNBA was very pleased with the Q&A and the one on one opportunities and that the developers. There will be a continuation several followup meetings with the hotel developer, the government of Aruba and the SNBA to address a number of important issues on several areas of this project, because will continue to be a part of all these developments.


