1. The writer met with Subject on 12 May 1964 in a final attempt to arrange a first schedule for his first trip to Berlin. At this meeting Subject advised that his business is still so short-handed that he and his wife continue to work 10-14 hour days and on weekends to keep abreast of the orders. Subject described All ansuccessful efforts to attract new employees and said he has little hope of finding any in the next few months. Given the fact that this situation has persisted now for six months, a further postponement of indefinite duration was unacceptable.

2. Subject was not terminated, however, because his conversion into an accommodation address -- a task compatible with his work demands -- had the advantage of giving us some return on the investment made in him. It should be pointed out that security was not a factor in this decision for Subject has given us no reason to fear that, once terminated, he would abuse our confidence. The writer explained to Subject what work his service as an accommodation address would entail and the purpose and importance of this task. He agreed readily to perform this assignment in lieu of CATRANSIT.

3. In view of Subject's location we are recommending him herewith to MOB as an accomposation address and are forwarding his file for your perusal. You will note that arrangements were made at the last meeting to permit an unassisted turnover to another case officer. Nevertheless, the writer can make himself available to introduce the MOB case officer to Subject. If MOB should prefer, FOE would undertake to employ Subject directly as an accommodation address, in spite of the distance involved. We would welcome an early reply to this proposal.

4. Headquarters: Please extend Subject's POA and amend it to reflect his intended use as an accommodation address.
