He accepted the CATRANSIT offer in December 1963, but repeatedly requested postponements of his first CATRANSIT mission because he was unable to find anyone to work in his business while he was away on a CATRANSIT mission. In July 1964, he asked for an indefinite postponement, and at that time it was decided not to use him in the CATRANSIT program. He was then offered to MOB as a CAGENERAL, and [] recruited him on 1 June 1964.
