Ellen Riotto began her role as Interim Executive Director of South Park Business Improvement District (BID). The BID is a 52-block area in Downtown Los Angeles. It is home to the Convention Center, L.A. LIVE, Staples Center, and the many cranes that pepper the downtown skyline. If the cranes aren't indication enough, there's a lot happening in South Park these days: the residential population is expected to triple in the next two years; the MyFigueroa project has begun construction along 11th St; and improvements to the Metro Pico Station are scheduled to begin later this month.
