Flag of the Race

NE of the most interesting series of stamps released by several of the Latin-American countries, was the "Day of the Race" issues. These stamps were issued in 1933 to commemorate the raising of the banger or flag symbolic of their race. In addition, the stamps commemorated the 441st anniversary of the sailing of Christopher Columbus from Palos, Spain, August 31, 1492, on his first voyage to the New World.

The "Flag of the Race" consists of three crosses which are taken to represent the three ships of Columbus, each of which had a large cross painted on its main sail. The center cross on the flag has a symbol in the background which is supposed to represent a raising sun.

Among the countries to participate in issuing these special stamps were Guatamala, Honduras, Nicaragua, Paraguay, Uruguay, and Brazil. In all, there were 66 different stamps put out by the six countries. Nicaraqua accounted for 36 of the different stamps of which 13 were for reqular postage, 11 for air mail use, and 12 for official use. Brazil issued one stamp as a good will gesture, for the country was not discovered and settled by the Spaniards but by the Portuquese.
