### Zanzibar

ONG before the time of Columbus, Zanzibar consisted of
Arab trading settlements extending along the entire eastern
coast of Africa from Somaliland
to Mozambique. These settlements were for the most part
inhabited by Mohammedan
Arabs who came by ships from
Indie, Persia and other eastern
seacoasts.

The existence of these settlements were unknown to the western world until 1498, when Vasco de Gama the Portuguese explorer first sailed around the Cape of Good Hope in his search for the water route to India. Da Gama landed at one of these Arab trading towns at a point in what is now Mozambique. He learned that gold was obtained from the interior and it was not long before he returned with a fleet and drove the Arabs out of the settlements. This was the first portion of the Zanzibar territory to fall to western invaders.

Stamps of Zanzibar have a somewhat magic appeal to stamp collectors for the name alone "gets" them. Not only are these stamps in demand because they are scarce and valuable, but also because in most stamp albums Zanzibar occupies the last pages and collectors wish to have some stamps on them.

One can readily notice that Zanzibar is under British influence for if any of the recent stamps of the country are held to the light one can see the watermark consisting of a multiple crown and script CA. This watermark is common to the stamps of British Colonies.
