

























SELF-DEFENSE TECHNIQUES ALL OVER THE WORLD

PERU'S MAGINOT LINE. To defend themselves against their enemies, primitive Peruvians in the 15th Century built a wall 1800 feet long and 60 feet in height. Guarding the city of Cusco, the wall contains gigantic stones fitted together so perfectly that a knife blade cannot be driven between them. The fort was so impregnable that no enemy ever tried to assault it.



LUCKYSTRIKE. A Tibetan lancer impales his enemy on a 35 foot spear, then withdraws it from the other side before his victim drops - all while riding at full gallop.

WAR GAMES. Iroquois Indians played lacrosse to keep their bodies physically fit for war. The games lasted for days with as many as 1,000 men playing on a field 10 miles long. Only the strongest survived to fight.




CAT SCENTS. A favorite method of defense against an enemy during the 16th century consisted of tying small containers of pestilential odors to wild cats and releasing them to the invaders.

IRON DEFENSE Natives of tiny Nias Island near Sumatra clad themselves in iron armor as a means of self-protection. They have originated the custom themselves without ever having come in contact with the outside world.



ARMED CLOTHING. Armor made of cloth was worn by 16th century Russian cavalry. Their shields were also worn as part of the armor.

SAVED BY A HAIR. During the defense of Carthage, human hair was used as armament to fill a shortage of rope for catapults.



OPERATION FIREWORKS. When an American brig, the Independence, was attacked by Malay pirates off the coast of Sümatra (1843), the ship's crew defended themselves by throwing lighted firecrackers at the enemy. Taken by surprise the pirates fled in terror!

GONE WITH THE WIND. Australian aboriginies foil pursuers by wearing round shoes which leave no heel or toe marks. The soles are covered with feathers of the emu, an ostrich like bird.



BATTLE OF ECHOES. Led by St. Germanus, a small band of Britons defeated an invading horde of Saxons by singing "Hallelujah." Assembled in a narrow mountain pass, their echoes sounded like a great army shouting, and the enemy fled in panic (430 A.D.).

THE DEATH BLOW. Natives of the jungles of Borneo and Malaysia are dead shots with the blowpipe, a tube 7 feet long containing a poisoned dart. They have successfully defended themselves against all invaders by being able to blow the poisoned darts distances of 70 yards with deadly accuracy.





JUDO MEN. In Japan 4 yearsof intensive study are required in order to master Jiu Jitsu. Students of the technique must know 3 different systems and more than 300 movements. A Jiu Jitsu expert never eats meat and drinks at least a gallon of water per day.

WEAPONS IN FLIGHT. Boomerangs, perfected as instruments of defense by Australian savages ages ago, utilized principles of mechanical flight which were rediscovered centuries later in the science of aeronautics.





SOUTH SEA KNIGHTS. Inhabitants of the Gilbert Islands used to weave armor from coconut fibres. They were helmets made from the dried skin of blowfish and carried swords made of sharks teeth.

HEAT WAVE. Natives of Fly River, New Guinea, live in tall tree houses and when attacked, pour boiling water on the enemy.

DOG FIGHTS. Dogs in ancient Greece were fitted with spiked collars and trained to attack enemy soldiers and horses.


