PEAS.

The Buist's Morning Star Pea which we introduced a few years since is the earliest and most productive variety known, and is regarded by Market Gardeners as their best and most profitable shipping variety. For protection to ourselves and to insure the purchaser the true stock, we sell them only in our Sealed Packages and Lead Sealed Sacks, each Seal is stamped Buist. The sacks are of green muslin and contain $\frac{1}{8}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, or one bushel each. Its great popularity has caused almost every dealer to catalogue them and a cheap grade of Extra Earlies is substituted. Observe, unless they are put up in green sacks and sealed with our name, they are spurious.

Over one-half the Peas sold in this country are grown without any regard to their purity—the result is the varieties become very much mixed, are full of runners, and produce very small pods. All low priced peas offered are of this stamp.
