Flowering Crab Apples:

Pyrus Coronaria Odorata. Fragrant Garland-Flowered Crab. Single blush flowers, with the fragrance of sweet violets; blossoms about a week after those of the Double Rose-Flowered. May.

Pyrus Floribunda. Single flowers in wonderful profusion; beautiful carmine in bud; white when open. May. Fruit very ornamental in autumn.

Pyrus Floribunda Atrosanguinea. Flowers crimson, in great profusion.

Pyrus Halleana (Parkmanni) Habit dwarf; a compact grower. Foliage dark green, remaining late on the tree. Flowers very double, dark rose, drooping, and retain their color until they drop from the tree.

Pyrus Ioensis var. Bechtel's. Bechtel's Double Flowering American Crab. Tree of medium size, covered in early spring with a large, beautiful fragrant flower of a delicate pink; from a distance they have the appearance of small roses. Blooms when quite young and late in the season, after the others.

Pyrus Scheideckeri. A fine variety from Germany. Flowers quite double, red in bud, changing to pink or rose color. Yellow fruit.

Pyrus Spectabilis var. flore albo pleno. Chinese Double White-Flowered Crab. Double white fragrant flowers in clusters. May.
