Production must be maintained. The soils of the Nation need restoring. Again there is a desperate need for legume seed. The following special payments will be made to farmers for harvesting and marketing especially needed seed:

**9 cents a pound for Red Clover
7 cents a pound for Alfalfa
7 cents a pound for Alsike
Clover**

In most States there are other aids to encourage farmers to harvest their seed. Get full information from your County Conservation Office (AAA). See your county agent for production ideas.

Tips: Cut hay crop early to allow plenty of time for seed crop.

In irrigated areas, use water sparingly. Rank growth means less seed.

Honeybees in the field help pollination—April increase the seed crop.

Cut early in morning, when plants are wet with dew, to prevent shattering.
