- 425 Heinrich Munch (H. P.) It has every characteristic of the Druschki. The petals are beautifully reflexed. Pink.
- 40 Helvetia (H. T.) Inside of petals bright pink, outside fiery red.
- 105 Hiawatha (H. Wich.) Flowers rich crimson with white center.
- 40 Juliet (Hybrid Briar). The outside of the petals old gold; the interior, rich rosy red, changing to deep rose.
