For example, Turnip Seeds for summer shipment will be sold at Wholesale at over double price, and then there will not be half enough to go round.

TERMS OF SALE

60 DAYS FROM DATE OF SHIPMENT, OR 2 PER CENT. OFF IF PAID IN 10 DAYS, EXCEPT NET CASH GOODS, SUCH AS ALL FARM SEEDS, RAPE, SUNFLOWER, AND ON BIRD SEEDS, UNION SETS, POTATOES, AND LAWN GRASS. ALL GOODS F. O. B. BRISTOL, PENNA. CARRIERS, SUCH AS BAGS, BOXES, CRATES AND BARRELS, AT COST.

 Interest will be charged for accounts overdue. Please notice.

All orders are taken subject to confirmation by D. Landreth Seed Company.

OUR SALES of Seeds are **OUTRIGHT**, and purchasers are asked to observe that we will not agree to the **RETURN OF UNSOLD STOCK, whole or in part.** If goods are shipped according to instructions and according to route and date indicated, our responsibility ceases. All errors on our part, to receive attention, must be reported within **TEN DAYS** after receipt of Seeds.

 All orders placed with us in advance of the harvest are **ALWAYS SUBJECT TO CROP RETURNS**, as no grower can be legally bound to furnish Seeds which the conditions of nature do not perfect. From new customers cash with order or satisfactory references.

Peas, Beans and Corn are all sold by the unit of 100 pounds. The prices for small Seeds **UNDER** ten pounds will not apply to quantities **LESS** than one pound. A slight advance will be made for fractions. The prices **OVER** ten pounds will not apply to less quantities.

No written quotation is good for longer than the time specified, and when no time is mentioned the quotation is good only for acceptance by **RETURN MAIL.**

In cases where Seed Orders are mailed by Merchants in response to **our quotations by letter**, we ask our customers in their letter to us to give the date of our letter to them making such quotation, else there is no guarantee of the prices quoted being given and the Seeds will be billed at current prices which may be higher.

SEEDS WILL NOT BE TAKEN BACK under any circumstances, and if shipped us will be **REFUSED** as **NO CREDIT** will be allowed, nor will any rebates be allowed for barrels, bags, boxes, crates or other carriers. This must be distinctly understood as prices are fixed on this basis.

Wire your Orders—Supplemental Orders Especially

We will pay the **telephone** charges on all near-by seed purchases, and **night letter telegram** charges from anyone, however distant, provided the order amounts to over \$10 for fine seeds and over two hundred pounds of Peas, Beans or Sugar Corn. Our telephone numbers are 36 or 37 Bristol, Penna.

We depend upon the judgment of the buyer not to use either telephone or telegram if there remains time to send the order by mail under a two-cent postage stamp.

Landreths' Seeds UNDER SEAL

LANDRETHS' SEEDS were the first Seeds sold in sealed packages, as in 1839 Landreth inaugurated the pasting down or sealing of flap packets, which before that date, and yet by some, had always been sold in folded packets, and since that date a portion of all Landreths' Seeds have been sold in various forms of sealed packages. Besides, they make a fine display and are quickly handled.

Landreths' Seeds are sold as follows :

1. **SEALED FLAT PACKETS**—In sealed flat colored lithographic **PACKETS**, in ounces and fractions of ounces, as in the past.
2. **SEALED CARDBOARD PACKAGES**—In sealed colored lithographic **CARDBOARD BOXES**, of 1-4, 1-2 and 1-pound quantities of Small Seeds, and of 1-3 pint and 1-pint packages of Peas, Beans and Corn.

Merchants are asked to pay special attention to our square **CARDBOARD SEALED PACKAGES**, as they are a guarantee against wastage, mixture and a saving of much trouble, as compared with handling loose Seeds, that is, Seeds in bulk. These packages are very handy, make a fine display and sell themselves.

3. **SEALED BULK**—All Bulk, large or small, will be issued in cloth bags fastened with flat lead seals bearing the impression of a bell on one side and an inscription on the other of D. L. S. Co.

THESE 1000 PACKETS OF SEED RETAILING AT \$50

This illustration of Landreths' Counter Seed Case is of one made of lithographic steel, very handsomely grained. The capacity of the 40 pockets is 1,000 Seed Packets, costing at wholesale \$20, the familiar Landreth Rooster Show Card serving all the time as an attractive invitation to purchase. The case is so constructed that each packet is so placed as to show its name and picture whether the packets be full or not. Altogether, the case is a decided improvement upon any Seed case ever issued.

Sales on outright plan only. The packets, wholesaled at 2 cents each, retail for 5 cents each, or \$50 per thousand, thus affording a profit to the merchant of 150 per cent. over cost. This case is the property of the D. Landreth Seed Company, but we supply a new case every three years, if necessary.

The lithographic packets are colored true to nature and are all from photographs taken on this farm—not pictures conceived in the brain of an artist.



The contents of all these Cases are made up by us after the personal selection of the Merchant, consequently only those Varieties which are marked with a star, ★, are found in the Cases and, therefore, every packet can be sold.

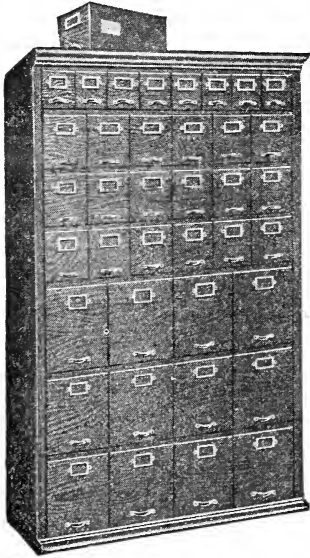

Landreths' Packets of Seeds contain as much seed as those sent out by any Seedsman and more than nine-tenths of the contents of the packets of other seed houses. They are very handsomely lithographed.

They are put up the same year they are issued, so always contain new Seed. Landreths do not send out Seeds on commission, thus have no old packets to send out year after year until sold, as is the case with commission Seed packets.

In buying Landreths' Packets the Merchant selects the varieties which sell in his particular locality and the number of packets he thinks he will require of each kind—no unsalable stock; and this personal selection enables him to sell out nearly his entire purchase of Seeds, but in commission boxes all are of the same cast-iron assortment, whether suited to the locality or not.

Landreths' Flat Packets

We sell our colored lithographic Flat Packets on the Outright Plan at the wholesale price of two cents each, which is \$20 per thousand. These Seed Packets retail at 5 cents each, or \$50 per thousand, affording the Merchant a net profit of 150 per cent. clear over his expenditure.

The number of varieties of Seeds put up in Flat Packets comprise about 175 sorts—less than half the number of varieties offered in bulk, those selected varieties put up in Flat Packets being the sorts most generally used, being indicated on the Price List by a **STAR (★)** opposite each variety. Seeds not so marked with a **STAR (★)** are not put up in flat packets. On an order of 500 packets we furnish a durable, white enameled cardboard Case, and with an order for 1,000 packets we furnish a fine steel Seed Display Cabinet free of cost, but which Cabinet is the property of the D. Landreth Seed Company, and is good for three years or more. See page 5.

Peas, Beans and Corn we do not sell in flat lithographic packets, but only in bulk or in square cardboard packages with colored lithographic labels.

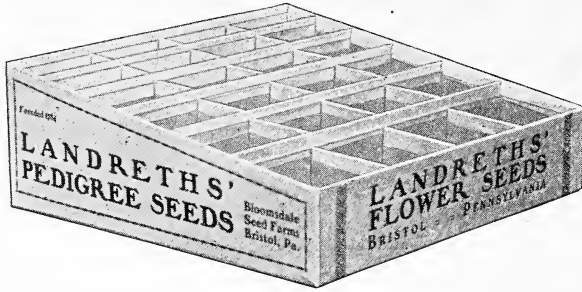
