BALLED AND BURLAPPED

These trees can be planted with absolute safety as they are hand dug with a solid ball of earth and burlapped. This prevents their roots being exposed. All are grown in wide rows and are fully developed. Each alternate year they are transplanted, which makes heavy, fibrous roots—so necessary to their success.

The variety of foliage borne by the different varieties of Evergreens will surprise you; silver, pea-green, gold, blue and a myriad of other shades for your approval. Evergreens grouped together will give wonderful effects. Group the different varieties together (such as Junipers, Firs, Pines, etc.) or use trees of the same variety.

An Evergreen conifer bed will also be a source of constant pleasure and beauty. Small trees are usually preferred, placing the taller growing species in the center. Evergreens for borders are indispensable to any well kept lawn. The trees grow more beautiful each year.
