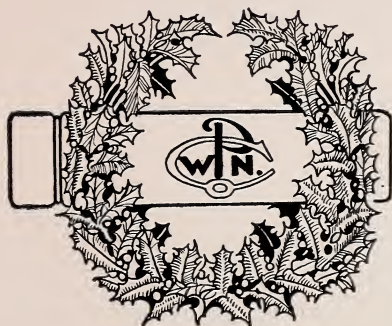

THIS Price List will be followed by Surplus Lists at intervals during the season. If you do not receive these we would consider it a favor if you will send us your name and address for our mailing list, and they will be mailed to you as issued.

Prices in this list are intended for the TRADE only. If this list reaches anyone not entitled to it, we would appreciate being advised of the fact, so we may correct our mailing list.

The new standard of grading adopted at the last meeting of the Pacific Coast Association of Nurserymen is used in this list. Kindly make your orders accordingly.

We do not employ Agents and no Dealers are authorized to use our name.

CANCELLATION.

We are glad to accommodate our customers by reselling stock they may have ordered from us and find they cannot use if we can find a market for it, but it is manifestly unfair to insist on our cancelling an order if we can not resell it, and in self-defense are obliged to refuse to do so.

SUBSTITUTION.

If you wish us to substitute in case we are sold short of any variety ordered, please so state, as we do not substitute unless requested to do so.

SHIPPING SEASON.

Our packing season commences from October 1st to October 15th and continues until from April 1st to May 1st, varying with the season.

GUARANTEE OF GENUINENESS.

While we exercise the greatest care to have every tree or plant true to name, and are ready, on proper proof, to replace anything sent out by us that may prove untrue to label, free of charge or refund the money paid for it, it is understood and agreed, between the purchaser and ourselves, that we are not to be held liable for any greater sum than that paid us for said trees that may prove untrue.

LOCATION.

We are located at 971 Sandy Boulevard, opposite the Old People's Home. To reach our place take Rose City Park cars on Washington Street, between Fifth and Second Streets, and get off at East Thirty-second street. You are invited to call on us when in the city, and we would take pleasure in taking you out to see our growing nursery stock, several good blocks of which are near town.

Terms and Conditions of Sale

PRICE herein quoted are for first-class stock of the grades named, but are subject to change without notice.

Five of a variety will be furnished at the Ten rate, Fifty at the Hundred rate and Five Hundred at the Thousand rate.

Orders should be made on a separate sheet, and not in the body of a letter, always giving plainly the postoffice, destination and route the goods are to be forwarded by.

Our terms are cash or satisfactory references before shipment; to established nurserymen who are known to us, or who give the necessary references, a credit of 60 days from date of invoice will be allowed, with a discount of 3% for cash with order, 2% in 10 days, and 1% in 30 days. A liberal deposit is expected to be made on orders for future delivery. All bills must be paid by June 1st or interest accrues from then or any prior date of maturity, at the rate of 8% per annum. This does not apply on supplies, which are a cash proposition and handled on a close margin, partly as an accommodation.

C. O. D. orders must be accompanied by a remittance to cover one-third of the cost of the order.

If shipment is made to a prepay station, a remittance sufficient to cover the freight charges must accompany the order.

All orders will be carefully packed, for which a moderate charge will be made to cover the cost of material and labor.

All shipments are at the risk of the purchaser after being delivered in good condition to the forwarders. Purchaser must be responsible for any loss or delay that may occur through the negligence of forwarders or horticultural inspectors. We will use every means possible to secure prompt delivery but are not liable for delays in transit, and our responsibility will cease upon delivery in good order to the carrier company, and the remedy for loss must lay between the purchaser and carrier company.

All claims for shortage or damage must be made within ten days of receipt of stock, or they will not be allowed. We book all orders with the understanding that same shall be void should injury befall the stock from Flood, Fire, Frost, Drought, or other causes beyond our control.
