***RATINGS.** The figures given before each variety are the ratings given by the Jury appointed by the American Iris Society in 1921. The highest rating (9.6) was given to Lent A. Williamson—which is included in the above collection. Princess Beatrice was second, also listed above.

I have a gorgeous collection of choice Japanese Iris, but as the nomenclature of Japanese Iris has never been properly determined, I do not sell them by name. I offer one each of ten choice distinct varieties, without labels for.....\$5.00.

PLANTING

The best time for transplanting Irises is after they are through flowering, in July, August or September. The varieties offered are perfectly hardy and will bloom anywhere if given some sun. Do not plant too deep. The best method is to plant so that the rhizome or fleshy part of the root, is just level with the ground. A light covering of leaves or straw, or rough trash is beneficial the first winter, especially if they are planted late in the fall, to prevent frost from throwing them out of the ground. After the first year they require no attention excepting to divide them every three or four years. Avoid manure and over-watering. Bone meal is an aid to flowering. . . . A complete listing of several hundred varieties will be sent as soon as it can be prepared.
