#### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ORDERING

The prices in this list are figured on a cash basis and do not include payment of transportation on bulbs larger than  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch in size. Number five, number six bulbs, and bulblets are shipped charges paid. If you wish bulbs shipped by parcel post be sure to include sufficient postage. The shipping weight on bulbs when packed are about as follows per 100: No. 1 eight lbs., No. 2 five lbs., No. 3 three lbs., and No. 4 two lbs. We pack bulbs carefully for safe shipment and do not charge for packing.

Except with persons or firms who have established credit with us full cash must be paid before shipment. 25 per cent deposit will hold orders for future shipment, when bulbs will be sent C. O. D. for the balance if you wish or balance may be sent any time before shipment. 3 per cent discount for full cash with order. Orders for bulblets will not be held later than April 1st, and for bulbs not later than May 1st.

While we exert the greatest care to have everything true to name we will not assume any responsibility for errors that may occur other than to replace any stock that may prove untrue, or refund the amount paid for same.

We shall try to put out true to name, disease free, young stock at the lowest price that first-class stock can be grown. We have ample space for the established rotation with legume crops and the best equipment obtainable for the economical growing and handling of our crop insuring good stock and low prices which is a combination hard to get.

Some varieties and sizes are omitted from this list as orders have already exhausted our stock and it is our policy to sell only stock of our own growing.

If in the market for varieties not in this list ask us for prices. We grow about 500 other varieties in our test gardens and have large enough stock of many of them to sell in wholesale lots but the stocks are too small to include in this list.

We can furnish most of these varieties of bulblets in peck and bushel lots. If interested write for prices.

The following offers are made subject to prior sales. Prices quoted are for 1000 bulbs, 250 or more at the same rate. In lots of 50 to 250 add 10 per cent to these rates. In lots of less than 50 add 20 per cent to the thousand rate. In lots of 5000 or more of a variety write for special discounts stating how many you can use. Bulblets are quoted per quart, 1 pint at the quart rate.
