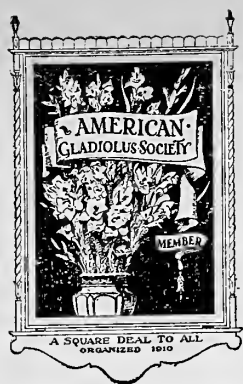

## AN OFFERING OF SUPER-GLADS

After many years of testing and rating GLADIOLUS, studies which I shall continue to pursue, I am adventuring in a new field, that of commercial bulb growing and selling. My list may not be as extensive as some, yet those offered are all choice varieties which attained ratings of 85 or better, excepting a few on which ratings are expected to be obtained during this season. These are listed only because friends who have seen them have given me unstinted recommendations, and because they are from originators who are keenly critical of what they introduce. Descriptions are necessarily brief. I respectfully bid for some of your patronage, with the assurance that all stock furnished will be healthy and true to name, and that any proving otherwise will be cheerfully replaced the following season.

### CULTURAL INSTRUCTIONS

An open sunny situation. Preferably a rich loamy soil, though most any type except a stony one will do. For hand cultivation, rows should be about 18 inches apart, thirty inches for wheel hoe, and three feet for horse cultivation or garden tractor. I find three to five inches a suitable depth, with small bulbs and bulblets more shallow, about two inches deep. Bulbs should be set about twice their diameter apart in the row, planting from the time the ground can be worked in spring up to June 15. Bulblets should be planted as early as possible. Cultivate frequently, and as soon as possible following a rain. Cut spikes when first bloom is open, leaving at least four leaves per plant to insure maturity of bulb for another season. Dig from September to November, beginning with bulblet stock and finishing with large bulbs. Twist foliage off when digging, cure in sun for few hours, finish curing in dry room for a week, clean and store cleaned stock in a cool frost proof place free from excessive dampness or dryness. Do not pack away too deeply.

NO ORDER ACCEPTED for less than \$50. ORDERS FILLED in rotation as received, when weather permits.

### CANADIAN CUSTOMERS PLEASE NOTE.

It will be necessary for you to obtain a permit from the Secretary of the Destructive Insect and Pest Act Advisory Board, Department of Agriculture, Ottawa, and file same with the Collector of Customs. Advise me of the number of this permit when you place your order so I can put it on package to expedite clearance of shipment.

PRINT NAME AND ADDRESS. WRITE ORDER PLAINLY.

Twelve bulbs will be furnished at 10 times each price, except those marked Stock Limited. In a few instances patrons are limited to purchase of a few bulbs of a variety, so that these receive as wide distribution as possible.
