PRICES quoted herein are to close out stock on account of discontinuing business. They are absolutely net for cash whether the purchaser buys for pleasure or profit. In other words, there is no discount to the Trade. Five plants will be sold at the rate for ten and not less than twenty-five will be sold at the hundred rate.

TERMS. Cash with order. Remittance may be made by postoffice order, express order or bank draft, PAYABLE TO "MOVILLA GARDENS."

ORDERS will be accepted subject to stock being unsold when they are received. They will be numbered consecutively and will be filled accordingly. Shipping season begins September 1st. If stock is exhausted when order is received, we will notify purchaser who may substitute another variety or have his remittance returned. Of the rarest and choicest varieties stock is very limited and in some cases we can supply only two or three divisions. Consequently the earliest orders will be the only ones we can fill.

C.O.D. ORDERS will not be accepted and stock will not be reserved unless paid for.

SHIPMENTS will be forwarded by express collect unless purchaser directs otherwise. If purchaser desires shipment to be made by parcel post, he should include 10c. with his remittance to pay postoffice fee for collection. The package will be insured and the postage collected on delivery. We advise express shipments whenever possible. The roots will be thoroughly washed and packed in damp moss. They should arrive in a moist condition but if dry should be submerged in clean water for a few minutes. If kept damp they may be kept out of the ground a week or two without sustaining damage. We make no charge for packing.

GUARANTEE. We guarantee every root absolutely true to name and if error should occur, we will replace with true stock or refund the amount paid.

SIZE OF PLANTS. Heretofore we have furnished only strong standard divisions having three to five eyes and such we strongly recommend to our friends and customers. We found last season, in dividing several thousand plants, we were left with many good divisions having only two eyes. These of course we planted and some of them will be saleable

this year as standard divisions. Some varieties, however, will not make euough growth in one season and these we must dispose of at a lower price. Furthermore the small divisions we make this year must be sold. We cannot plant them because we must surrender the land at the close of the season. For this reason we are quoting in this list, in first column, prices for small divisions of many varieties, These divisions will be such as several western growers call "one-eyed divisions" although many will have two and sometimes three eyes. The price figures in all columns except the first refer to Standard Divisions only. We can furnish one-year-old plants of many varieties at an advance of 50% over prices quoted for standard divisions. In some varieties we can furnish two-year-old plants at an advance of 50% above the price for one-year-old plants

COMPLAINTS, if made immediately on receipt of goods, will be investigated at once and, if due to our negligence or carelessness, will be promptly rectified.

We also have for sale a Skinner Sprinkler System, including a Gould Pump with gasoline engine and 600 feet of piping with standards; also a Bolens Tractor that has had but one year of use and is in good condition; also a Roovers Press for stamping metal labels.
