QUICK SHIPMENT: Our stocks cover practically everything In the field seed line and are carried in our warehouses ready for immediate shipment. Please note that we load all shipments at shipping stations of Philadelphia, scheduled to make quickest deliveries.

TIMOTHY: Market lower than for many years. The chief the market has opened on the new erop may be the unusual hay crops in all sections. The latest government report estimates the 1927 crop to be 10% to 15% greater than the 1926 crop. The linal outcome of the crop will not be definitely known for some time to come, but prices are ruling far below earlier expectations.
