CROP REPORTS: At this season we receive reports daily from producing sections on various field seed crops. Upon request it will give us pleasure to give our friends this crop information more in detail than is possible on this card.

QUICK SHIPMENT: Our stocks cover practically everything in the field seed line and are carried in our warehouses ready for immediate shipment. Please note that we load all shipments at shipping stations of Philadelphia, scheduled to make quickest deliveries.

TIMOTHY: Market lower than for many years. The chief factor contributing to the very low price at which the market has opened on the new crop may be the unusual hay crops in all sections. The latest government report estimates the 1927 crop to be 10% to 15% greater than the 1926 crop. The final outcome of the crop will not be definitely known for some time to come, but prices are ruling far below earlier expectations.

ALFALFA: Demand has been heavy; prices slightly lower, conforming with the new crop prospects. Please note that we are not handling Southern grown Alfalfa seed, now available

at very low prices. Our stocks are certified as to origin, and are not mixed with Southern grown seed.

RED CLOVER: Domestic crop reported favorably in many sections, indicating larger crop than has been harvested for some time past. Stocks old seed practically exhausted.

ALSYKE: New crop is coming on the market very slowly. We are handling only new crop seed. Note quotations below.

SEED GRAINS: Kindly note quotations on various seed grains required for Fall seeding. Please note especially the "Forward" variety which is a smooth growing Wheat of the Lancaster Fulcaster variety, and is free of smut.

LAWN GRASS: Fall seeding of lawn and grass seed as well as the pasture mixtures is recommended as producing a stronger root growth to withstand the drought of summer.
