

REGAL—One of the biggest western introductions having crown blooms of eleven inches or more. For such size of flowers it is an exceedingly good bloomer. Color is a combination of autumn shades, bronze, old rose shading to gold at base of petals. Stems long and rigid. Net \$10.00
KEMP'S VIOLET WONDER—Best violet colored Dahlia to date, but not of solid color. Reverse has underlying tone of royal purple and lavender. Strong and vigorous growing plants producing exceptional amount of good tubers. Flowers on long stiff stems standing off from foliage nicely
MY MARYLAND—A grand Hybrid Cactus of delicate pink with faint tinge of lavender on stems of extra length and rigidness. Plant is very rugged \$7.00
NANCY SUE LANG—A very large flowered variety. The color is bright red tipped gold. The plant is inclined to be dwarf, but stems are stiff\$3.00
MR. E. LEEDHAM—A huge flower of great depth and diameter. Color is orange scarlet and does not burn in sunshine. Stems are long, carrying flower on top. Plant is tall growing and free blooming. \$7.00
AMARILLO GRANDE—Large Hybrid Decorative flower of light yellow. Petals are broad and center is always closed. Plant grows medium with good foliage\$ 2.50
JUDGE SHINN—A deep chrome decorative having a yellow center. Flowers are large and of good depth on wiry, stiff stems. Large growing plant sometimes attaining a heighth of 8 or 9 feet
WALDEHEIM SUNSHINE—A peacock intro- duction that cannot be beat. A giant decora- tive of true deep yellow, which shown under artifical light, robs none of its rich color from it. Stems are long and stiff, holding the twisted petaled flowers at just the proper angle. Truly a prize winner

RUTH HOTTEL—One of Jersey's fine introductions. A good one toned cerise, on rigid stems, holding the good sized flowers perfectly. Plant is of the low growing variety\$ 2.00
EAGLE ROCK JEWELL—Cream overlaid shell pink. This Hybrid Cactus is considered the most artistic dahlia ever grown, the flowers are large and borne on strong stems, produced by a vigorous and free blooming plant. Two years ago this variety sold for \$50.00 a tuber. \$ 7.00
JERSEY IDEAL—This is a deep lavender-pink decorative. Flowers are held on an ideal stem, face up, with back petals falling down, making a very deep flower. Vigorous grower and free bloomer. \$ 2.00
JEAN HARE—A strikingly attractive Hybrid Cactus of immense size. The flower, when fully opened is a beautiful golden yellow with an outer row of golden bronze petals, borne on fine stiff stems at just the proper angle.
