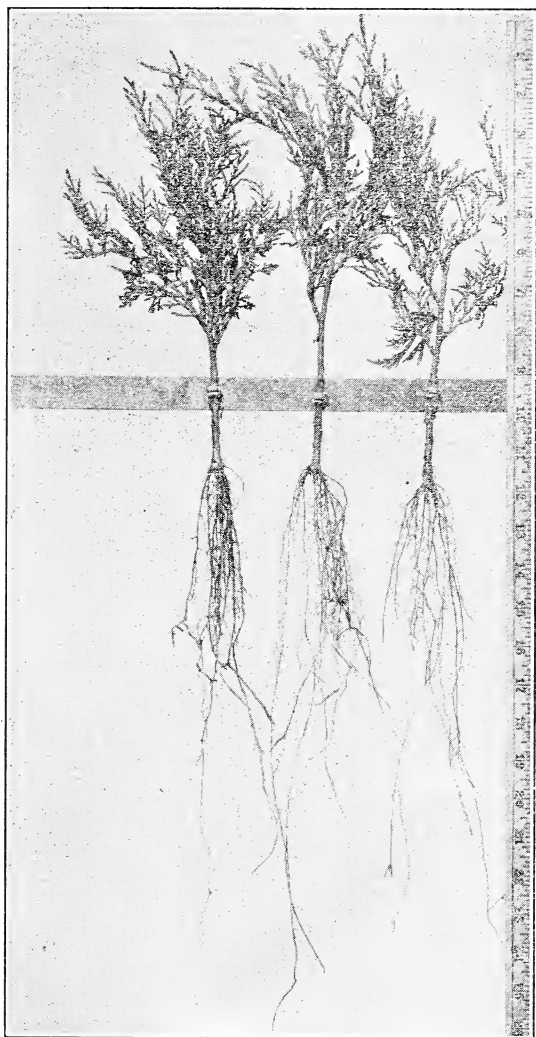

## Grafted Evergreens and Ornamentals

The Junipers listed below were grafted in early winter on blight-free Red Cedar understock grown under the most favorable conditions. The grafts will be ready for shipment after May 1st, 1929, and can be planted directly into nursery rows. Before ordering your fancy juniper grafts from firms listing them at low figures, better ascertain whether they were grafted on *Juniperus virginiana*, its natural understock, on which they will make a quick vigorous growth, or on *biota* or *communis*, on which the juniper will linger for years and eventually die.
