Our Alsike is also purchased tributary to Owatonna in sections that are free from thistle; thoroughly re-cleaned over our clipper and gravity mills, free from noxious weeds, with a guaranteed purity and germination.

SWEET CLOVER

Sweet Clover that is clean is very hard to obtain this year, especially seed that is free from mustard. We made a special effort and were fortunate in getting Sweet Clover that our tests show no mustard or noxious weeds, thoroughly scarified, with a high purity and germination.

ALFALFA SEED THAT IS BOTH HARDY AND CLEAN

is what every farmer wants when putting in a field of this valuable grass. It is getting more difficult every year to secure Alfalfa Seed that does not contain Sweet Clover, as well as noxious weeds. We can furnish you Grimm Alfalfa this year that our tests show to contain no noxious weeds. In fact, no weeds of any kind. In ordering this, ask for **CASHMAN BRAND**. Our Timothy seed is all locally grown, high in purity and germination.

This seed has a purity of 99.90 pure crop seed. With seed of this purity, new lawns can be started without weeds providing the ground has been properly cultivated.
