Cash account: Cash before shipment 10%.

C. O. D. 25% of amount of order to be remitted in advance of shipment, balance C. O. D.

Charge Account: Our terms are strictly 30 days net to customers who have established their credit with us. New charge accounts opened only upon receipt of satisfactory references.

Packing: Our packing is free of charge. For long distance shipping by express plants are shipped bare rooted in moss. Plants out of pots are wrapped separately in paper to reduce express charges.

Prices: As quoted are F. O. B. Inglewood, California.
