ISSUED MONTHLY—Always refer to the price list for the current month, as this list cancels all previous quotations and is made on a strictly CASH BASIS. NOT LESS THAN SIX OF ANY VARIETY AT DOZEN RATES AND TWENTY-FIVE AT HUNDRED RATES. No charges made for packing or delivering to Express Company on orders of \$1.00 or more. A packing charge of 25 cents will be made on all orders less than \$1.00. All goods travel at customer's risk, and any claim for damage should be made to the Express Company upon receipt of goods.

These prices are made on a strictly "CASH WITH ORDER" basis, regardless of the responsibility of the customer. We will however, allow 3% cash with order, 2% 10 days—all hills due net 30 days.

We wish it to be distinctly understood that while we take every precaution to have all plants and bulbs true to name, we give no warranty, express or implied, as to description, quality, productiveness, or any other matter, of any of the plants or bulbs we send out, and will not in any way be responsible for the crop. Every order we receive will be executed on these conditions only, and they must be accepted by the customer when ordering.

Please note that we make no charge for packing orders for more than \$1.00. On orders for \$1.00 or less, a packing charge of \$0.25 is made. To the customer who comes after plants bringing his own trays, we will allow a liberal discount for packing charge.

### JAPANESE BEETLE QUARANTINE

While we are in the Japanese Beetle Quarantine zone, it does not interfere with our shipping. Several intensive inspections have failed to discover any beetles within six miles of our place. All shipments are accompanied by a certificate.

Our stock is in splendid shape. We would call particular attention to our stock of pot grown Vinca Variegata. We never had a finer stock or a better variegated strain.

### FLORIDA PERMIT NOTES

We have a permit from the Florida State Plant Board to ship our stock into Florida.

We have prepared a special lot of 3-inch Lantanas, Coleus, Salvia, Fuchsias, Achyrantheras, Heliotrope and Geraniums to meet the Southern demand.
