MARKET CONDITIONS: There have been very few changes in values during the past month, so far as concerns the important field seed items. If anything, the tendency has been toward somewhat higher prices and this is very significant in view of general weakness prevailing in other mercantile lines.

RED CLOVER AND ALSYKE: Market about unchanged. Kindly note our Midwestern grown Red Clover is tagged, showing state of origin. The purity of Quaker brand Red Clover and Alsyke this coming Spring will be the highest in years. This has been brought about by careful selecting of original seed and by continued improvements and refinements in cleaning processes by which the Quaker standard is main-

WHITE SWEET CLOVER: Market strong. Our stocks are Dakota grown and of the finest quality.

ALFALFA: The latest reports from producing sections indicate that quantity of seed remaining in farmers' hands has been reduced very sharply during the past few weeks. In view of the short crop it would not be at all surprising to see higher prices on Alfalfa a little later. Grimm Alfalfa is very attractive at present. Note quotations below on finest quality in officially sealed bags.

These grasses make a permanent, close knit turf under favorable conditions, but without the quick growing nurse grasses used in the better known Ole Englieb grade, a quick growth must not be expected.
