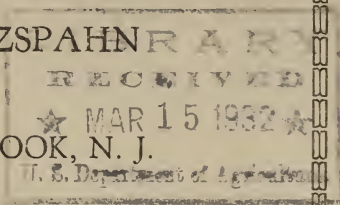

CONDITIONS OF SALE

Prices—This list cancels all previous offers. The prices quoted in this list are net and subject to no discount; 250, 25 or 5 of any one variety will be furnished at the 1000, 100, or 10 rates respectively.

Terms—Cash, security or satisfactory references are required from unknown parties. **All bills are due in thirty days from date of invoice after which time a carrying charge of (6%) six per cent. per year will be added.**

Complaints—Should there be any reason for complaint, we must be notified on receipt of goods, otherwise we cannot entertain it.

Orders—Are accepted on condition that they shall be void should any injury befall the stock from frost, or other causes over which we have no control.

We guarantee all our stock to be in good condition on leaving our hands, but we do not guarantee it to grow under all conditions, nor do we make up any loss whatsoever due to climate effects or after culture.

To Our Customers—On all orders placed with us, stock is sold at the nurseries without freight allowance. The plants become your property upon delivery of them to the Transportation Co., and we cannot be responsible for loss, damage or delay in transit. If plants arrive in bad condition, before receipting for them, require the Station Agent to note same on the freight or express receipt, then make your claim on the Transportation Co. If you accept shipments short of what is enumerated on your invoice or in bad condition without proper notation on freight or express receipt, the loss will be yours. Every assistance in our power will be cheerfully rendered you to trace and recover lost goods.
