GENERAL BUSINESS TERMS

TERMS -

No less than ~~25~~ fish or plants shipped at the per 100 price. Orders go forward only when sufficient funds to cover are accompanied with order. Shipments made C. O. D. (either by Express or Parcel-post), will go forward only when fifty (50%) percent of the total is sent with order to guarantee acceptance of same.

REPLACEMENTS -

We replace fish and plants ONLY WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A BAD ORDER SLIP FROM THE RAILWAY EXPRESS AGENCY. Please examine shipments on arrival and if such be the case, get this bad orderslip.

SHIPMENTS -

All shipments go forward in rotation, we reserving the right to ship either by Express or Parcel-post, whichever might be the safest at the time.

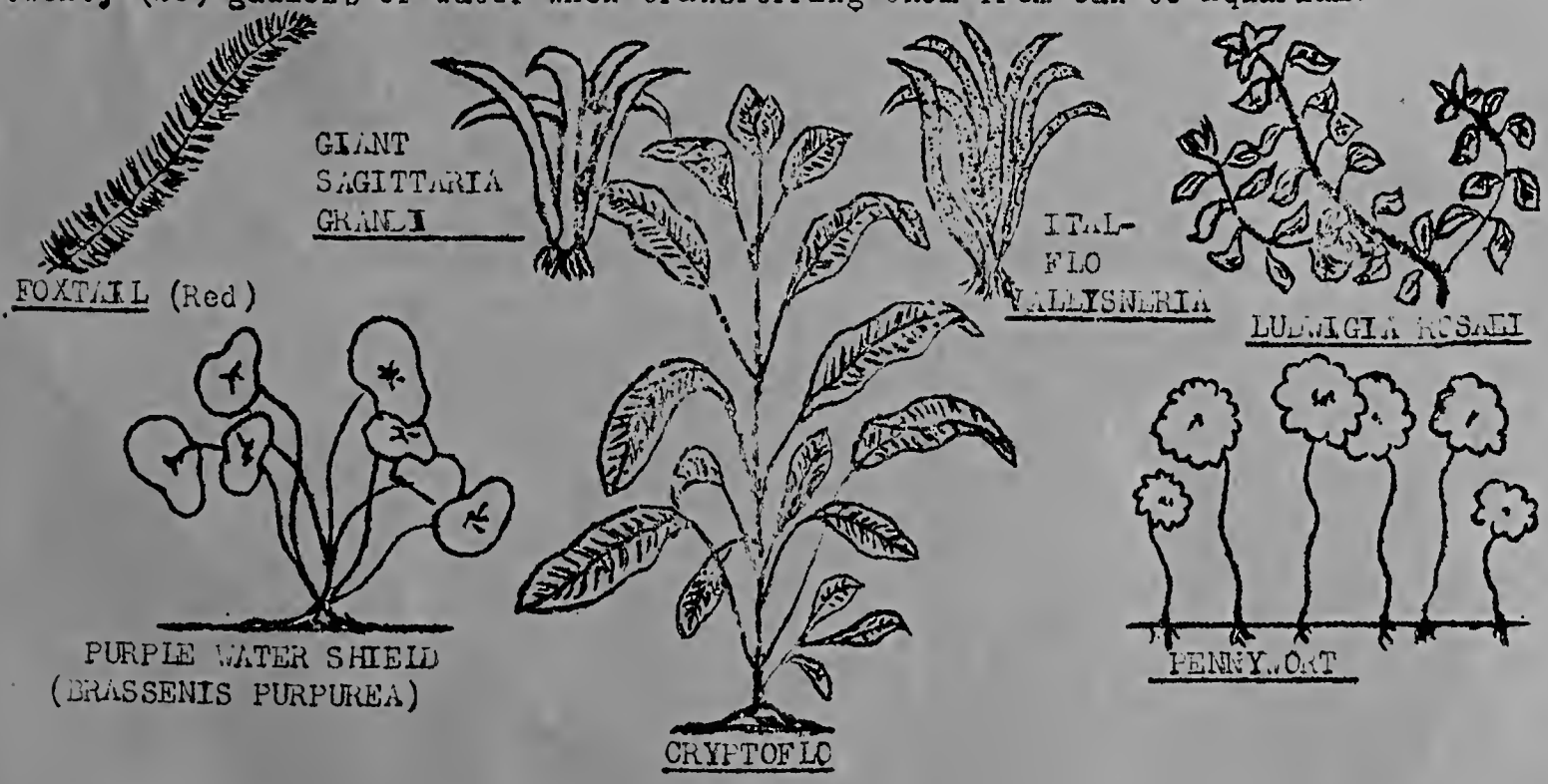
SHIPPING CANS -

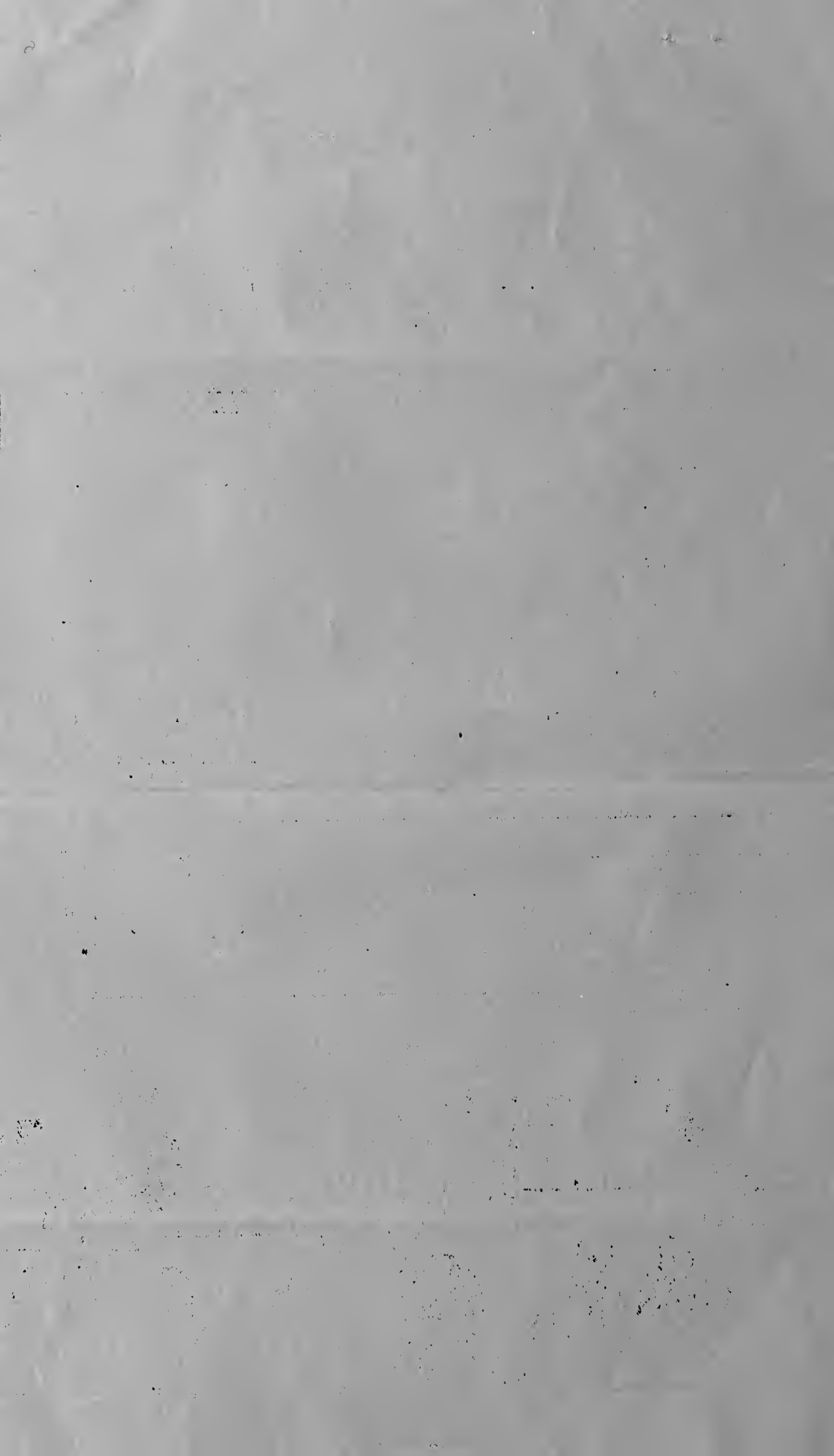
All fish go forward in the regular American shipping cans, for which we charge 50¢ per can and same is not returnable. Should you care to have us ship in the large German cans, we charge \$1.00 per can for same and on return of this can prepaid, we will either give you credit for the amount advanced or send you our check for same. During the months of October to April, we ship in thermos containers all fish (with the exception of such as Florida Tropicals, Paradise Fish and Black Mollienesiass, as these can stand the cold enroute). The price per thermos container is \$1.50 each for one gallon and \$2.50 for two gallon. These are returnable for credit when returned prepaid. Prepaying a returned can or thermos container, costs only 20¢.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO HANDLE FLORIDA TROPICALS -

MOLLIENESIA LATTIPINA - These fish are large fish and naturally require more oxygen and cool aquariums. On arrival of a can of these fish, it is best to put in a handful of sale to every twenty (20) gallons of water into the aquariums that these fish will be put. In this way, you will save all your fish. Should you try to crowd them, you will find that they will die from many causes. Mollienesias are good feeders, but be careful and see to it that they eat everything, as they very seldom eat food that fall to the bottom. Plenty of room, cool aquarium and a salt bath once in a while is the best for these fish.

On all other Florida fish, add about three teaspoonfuls of salt to every twenty (20) gallons of water when transferring them from can to aquarium.





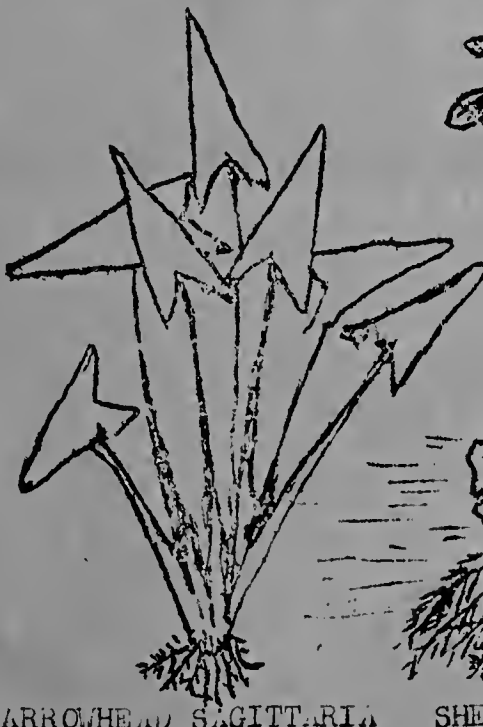
