These very showy garden flowers are among the easiest of culture, and most satisfactory of all perennials. They produce myriads of lilylike blossoms in various shades of yellow, ranging from a soft creamy yellow to the deepest orange. Some of them are shoulder high and others are low enough for use in the rock garden. Some of them flower during May in the latitude of New York; others flower during June, and still others through July and into August.
