PRIDE OF STRATFORD-A fine large dahlia inclined to be a little bashful. Color, cadmium orange shaded light orange yellow at base of petals, reverse rose doree ..... 50
*WALDHEIM SUNSHINE-This immense but graceful dahlia is rated among the best. It is a deep golden yellow, shad- ing to chrome yellow at center, while the reflex is lightly suffused scarlet. The form is excellent with full high center. The stems are strong and erect ..... 2.00

ORDER EARLY-To avoid disappointment please order early. All orders are filled strictly in rotation, stock will be reserved as orders are receivedi and shipped as desired. We will notify you if unable to supply any variety as we do not substitute.

ROOTS—All orders will be filled with strong divisions of field grown roots, AS SOON after April 1sť, as seems acivisable, unless otherwise specified.

GUARANTEE-We guarantee every root sent out by us to be true to name, also to be in growing condition when received, after which our responsibility ceases, as we have no control over growing conditions. Please notify at once if alnything is unsatisfactory when received. Any root that fails to grow within three weeks after being planted we will replace upon return of the old root. While we exercise the greatest care to have our stock true to name, should any prove otherwise, we will cheerfully replace; but it is mutually agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that we shall not at any time be held responsible for a greater amount thatn the original price of the stock.
