**H**ILLCREST DAHLIAS are grown in the Hills of West Virginia, where the climate and soil are ideal for Dahlia culture.

It is the object of the Hillcrest Gardens to produce stock that will grow anywhere, but we must have your co-operation in this. See that your soil tests P. H. 7. O. or near so. Have soil aerated with horse manure or some cover crop, as the organism of the roots must throw off carbon dioxide the same as the human animal. If you want to grow Exhibition Dahlias do not use cow, sheep or chicken manure. No manure is a fertilizer of any consequence.

Get a copy of the Mid-West Dahlia News, Volume 2, Number 4, which contains an analysis of the Dahlia ash, showing what mineral salts the Dahlia thrives on.

terested in commercial varieties.

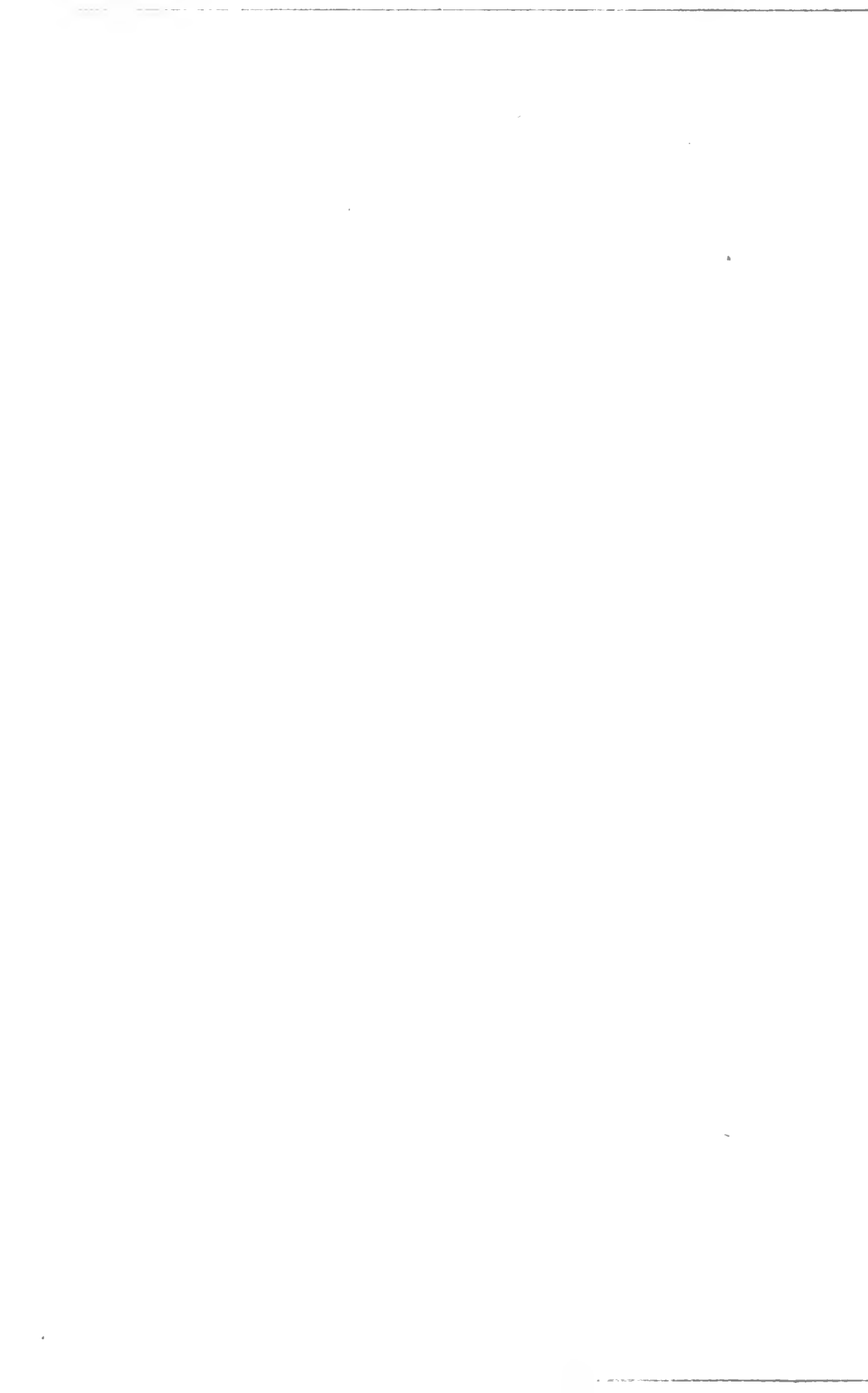

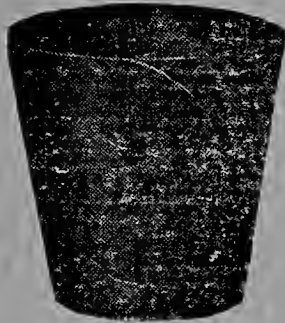
