

| NANDINA DOMESTICA—Field grown in wide rows, some with berries. Dug N.R. & puddled, 12-18 Inches, 12½c; 18-24 Inches, 17½c; 2-3 Feet, 25c; 3-4 Feet, 4 stems and up, 35c. Add 5c to the two lower grades and 10c to others if you want stock burlapped. |
