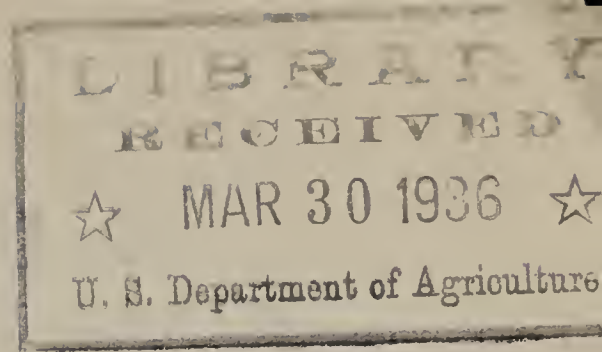

ABELIA—Heavy, 4 to 5 Feet, N.R.....	.15
4 to 5 Feet, B.&B.....	.25
ABELIA—Cut back last spring, about 18-24 Inches high with spread of 2 to 3 Feet; Fine for foundation planting. Price same as 4 to 5 Feet. Lighter grades of both kinds dug N. R., puddled, 10c; B. & B., 12½c.	
NANDINA DOMESTICA—Field grown in wide rows, some with berries. Dug N.R. & puddled, 12-18 Inches, 12½c; 18-24 Inches, 17½c; 2-3 Feet, 25c; 3-4 Feet, 4 stems and up, 35c. Add 5c to the two lower grades and 10c to others if you want stock burlapped.
