## COLD SMOKE CHINCH BUG CONTROL AND SOIL CORRECTOR

Is the safest, easiest, surest way of controlling Chinch Bugs in lawns. An effective control of Brown Patch. Will not burn or injure grass or plants in any way. An insect repellent; moles stay away from it. It is fine for mixing in a compost heap to make it break down rapidly.

Should be used when turning under a cover crop as it will hasten decay and correct acidity. Should not be mixed with or used at the same time with any fertilizer which contains acid phosphate or any sulphate, but is excellent with anything organic.

Use 5 or 6 pounds to 100 square feet. Spread evenly. Brush over with back of rake or anything light, to shake it down the soil, then sprinkle very lightly, just enough to moisten.

## COLD SMOKE DAMP OFF CONTROL

A fungicide, an insecticide, and a plant food, simple, easy and safe to use. Should be used in all soil in which seeds, roots, bulbs, or small plants are to be planted, whether it be in the greenhouse, garden or field. For best results mix in soil previous to planting for the control of Damp Off and insects.

The value of these materials lies in their remaining in the soil to prevent reinfestation. Having an alkaline reaction and being a stimulant to nitroifying bacteria they have a decided corrective effect on the soil. The material is fool proof as a little variation in quantity used makes little difference. Results obtained recommend its having a place in every greenhouse and garden.

Use 1 pound to 3 or 4 cubic feet of soil. Mix very thoroughly.

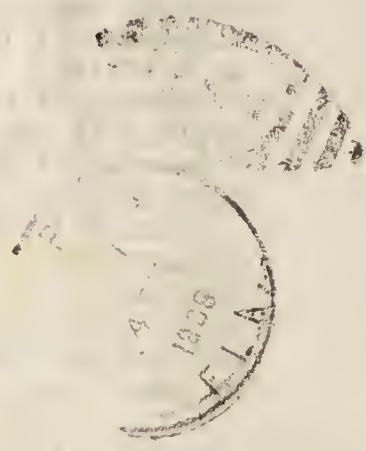
