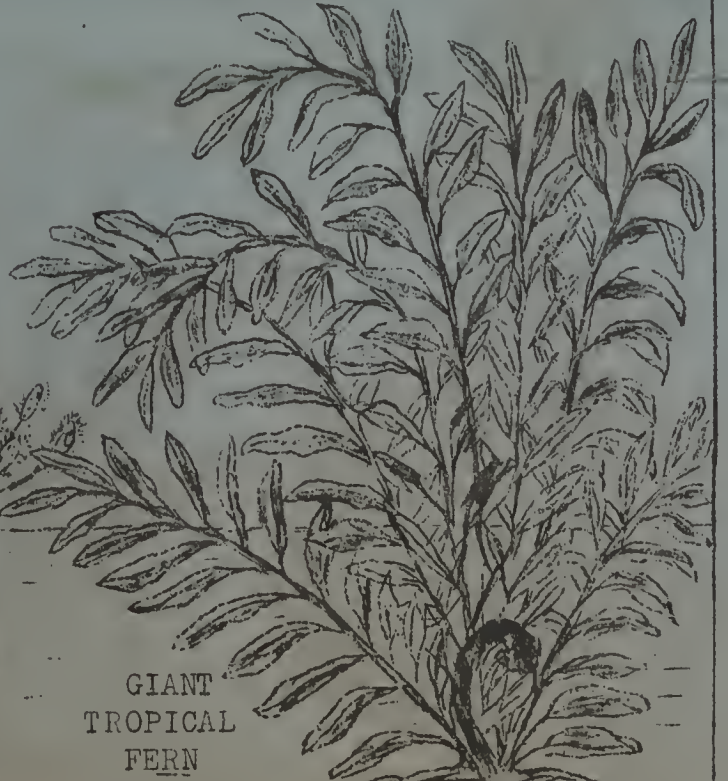

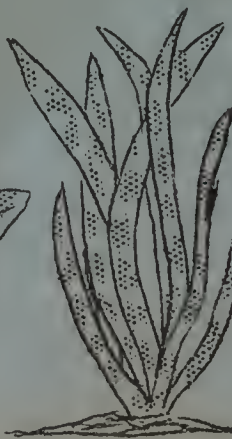

TROPICAL FISH AND HOW TO HANDLE ON ARRIVAL

All fish leave here in robust healthy condition, but on account of some trips being rather long, it is best to handle them carefully and properly when they arrive.

1st. Leave your telephone number with the Express people, with instructions that they call you immediately on arrival of the shipment.

2nd. Meet the train and take shipment off yourself. This eliminates the danger of a shipment being dragged all around town before it is delivered to you. Such trucking is dangerous, whether it be Winter or Summer.

3rd. Take thermometer with you and test water temperature at Express Office. If same is below 70, the fish have been chilled and you should get a Bad Order Report.

4th. On arrival home, it is always best to have a clean aquarium ready for the new arrivals. They should not be put with your other fish for at least two or three days. Strain the water from out of our cans and put as much of it as you can into your aquarium. Then, float our fish in jars into your aquarium, so that the temperature in jar equalizes with that in the aquarium. It is also best to add a little salt to your water, about three large teaspoonfuls to every twenty (20) gallons of water. This will act as a tonic.
