TERMS QUOTATIONS

The within prices will become void as follows:

Clumps: After December 15, 1938.

Roots: After February 1, 1939, if not revised earlier.

All offerings are subject to prior sale.

SHIPPING CHARGES

Root orders will be shipped prepaid.

Clump orders will be shipped charges collect if by express.

If shipment by mail is desired the purchaser will be required to refund shipping charges unless due allowance for this item is made in remittance accompanying order.

REMITTANCES

A deposit of 25% will be required to hold root orders for Spring delivery.

Clumps are cash with order.

Remittances may be made in any of the customary forms.

DELIVERY

Roots will be shipped on any specified date, weather permitting, after January 1st.

We usually commence digging shortly after November 1. Clump shipments commence to go forward immediately thereafter.

LIABILITY

We assume no responsibility for losses of clumps during the winter months. We exercise utmost care in selecting your clumps, avoiding immature stock, but if upon receipt of your order you are dissatisfied in any respect, please communicate with us at once.

GUARANTEE

We guarantee all stock to the extent of replacement or refund to be true to name and to be free from disease.

OUR STOCK

Clumps will have not less than three eyes with a sufficient number of roots to allow for as many strong divisions. Our stock is field grown, allowed to bloom naturally and fertilized expressly for quality root production. No less than 90% of our crop was planted from May 5 to May 25 which together with ideal growing conditions assures you of thoroughly matured stock.
