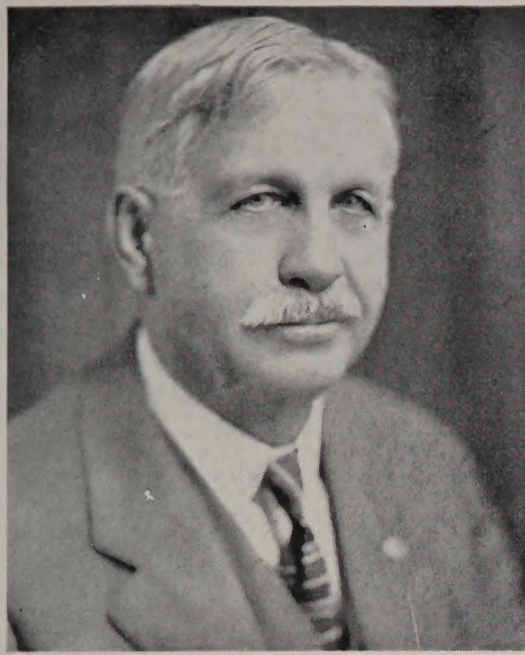

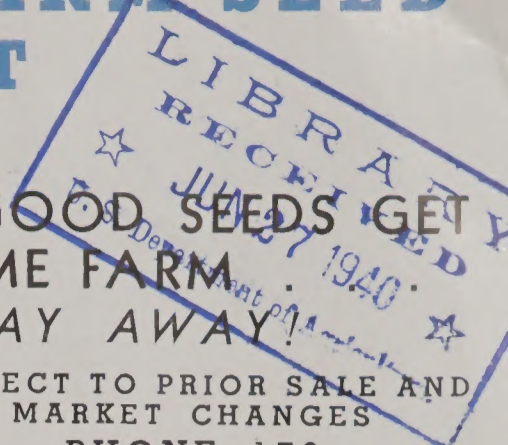
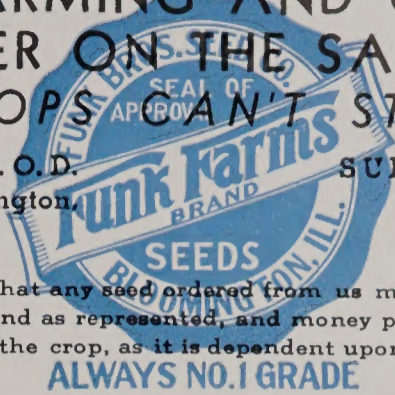

- 12% or 2.4 Lbs. Red Clover
- 7% or 1.6 Lbs. Alsike

- 24% or 4.8 Lbs. Rye Grass
- 10% or 2.0 Lbs. Korean Lespedeza

SOUR SOIL

Seed about 15 Lbs. per acre.
