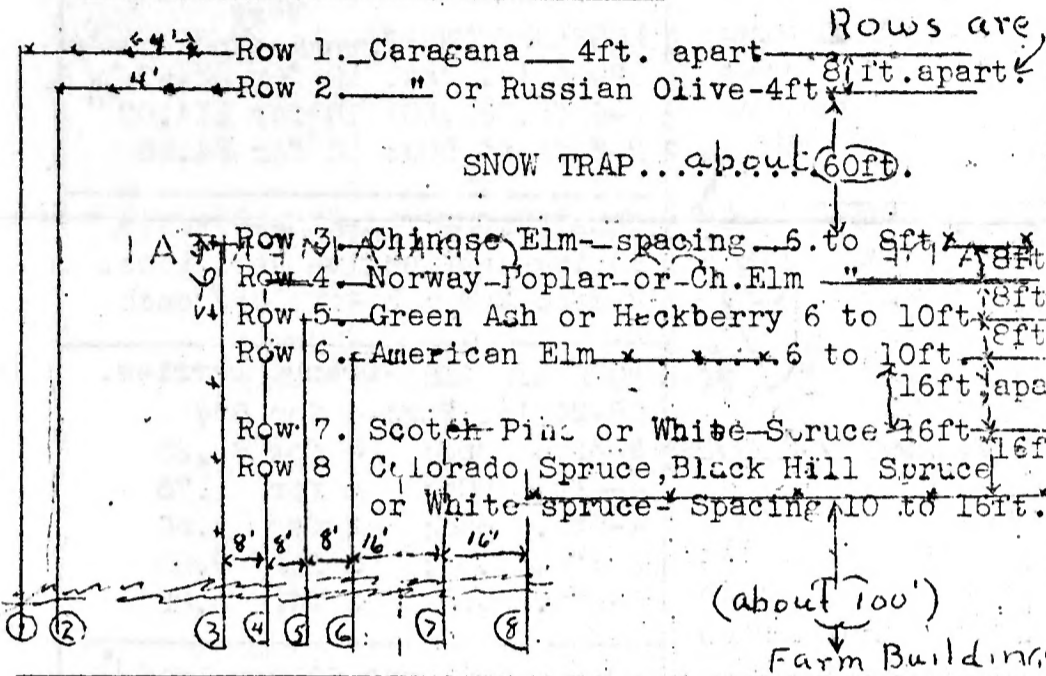

In order to get enough trees per acre (See below) use the following computations: If trees are 4 feet spaced and rows 6 ft. apart 1815 trees are needed to the acre etc. *MAJOR PRINCIPLE*
 4ft. x 4ft. takes 2723 trees "
 4ft. x 6ft. takes 1815 trees "
 6ft. x 6ft. takes 1210 trees "
 8ft. x 8ft. takes 975 trees "
 8ft. x 10ft. takes 680 trees "
 10ft. x 10ft. takes 540 trees "
 10ft. x 12ft. takes 430 trees "
 1st figure indicates space in between plants in row; 2nd fig. indicates distance between rows

NOTICE TO FARMERS GET PAID FOR PLANTING WOODLOT & WINDBREAK

AAA TREE SET-UP

The 1940 AAA farm program has set up a special allotment of \$7.50 per acre for planting trees. You would plant 4 acres of trees and berried shrubs to get the maximum tree allotment payment of \$30.00. By the check-up next fall you must have 300 trees living on each acre for windbreaks and 650 trees alive per acre for woodlot plantings. You will also receive \$3.00 an acre for cultivating and caring for these trees as also you will receive for any plantings done after July 1, 1936 if you have 300 good trees growing this fall (1940)

BUT THIS IS NOT ALL

You are also entitled to regular farm allotments on hay, alfalfa etc, and if you have a quota of about \$25.00 coming according to your particular farm soil building goal, you may put this all over on tree planting and receive \$30.00 plus \$25.00 or \$55.00 by planting a little over 7 acres of trees and shrubs suitable to wildlife etc. It may vary but the \$30.00 is the same for every farm plus \$3.00 per acre or \$42.00 for 4 acres, if cared for. One acre would bring \$10.50 and 2 1/2 acres would bring \$26.25 etc.
