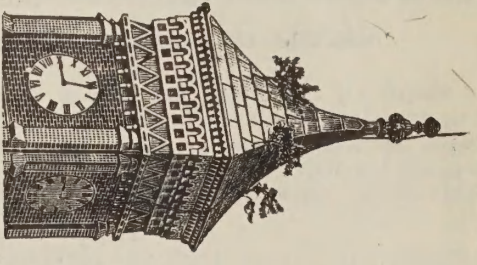

VISITORS WELCOME AT ALL TIMES

Order Early—This insures you reservation of stock that is scarce. Orders are booked and filled in rotation and shipments begin April 1. Southern customers may have them shipped earlier if they desire.

Guarantee and Terms—All stock is State and Federal inspected semi-annually and each shipment carries a copy of the tag. All stock is guaranteed true to name and is sent out in good growing condition. Orders are cash and postage is paid on all orders of \$1 or over. **Anything under \$1, customer adds 10c extra for postage.** If out of any item, I will substitute another similar variety.

Larger Quantities and Other Varieties—Many varieties are grown in smaller quantities that are not listed so if you wish a variety you do not see listed, write me, I may have it. If you are interested in a larger quantity of any one item write for prices.

OTHER BULBS AND PLANTS

Mexican Tuberoses—Single sweet scented lily-like waxy flowers—10c each or 3 for 25c.

Plants of Physostegia, Chelone, Decorative Day Daisies, Monarda, Coreopsis and Veronica—10c each or 3 for 25c.

Button and Pompon Chrysanthemums in assorted colors and a limited amount—\$1 per dozen.

These are all hardy and come in a varied assortment of colors.

DAHLIA COLLECTIONS

Surprise Collection—12 for \$1.00. I have featured this collection for several years and have many replies from customers telling me how well pleased they were and how much pleasure they had from their blossoms. It is made of large flowering double dahlias, each one a different variety and the name is labeled on the root. Many are listed in the folder and others are from the rest of the crop that is not listed. The selection is left to me but I assure you will be more than pleased. Try a collection.

Unlabelled Collection—20 for \$1.00. These are taken from the entire crop, mixed and unlabelled. They are from all types, large, small, etc. and I can't guarantee what you will get but know they will make nice cut flowers at a cheap price.

Ball-Pompon and Miniature-Cactus Collections—10 for \$1.00. The selection is left to me and each bulb will be different and so labelled on the root with its true name. The collections may be mixed if you so desire and will specify in your order.

PREMIUM BULBS

For early orders, sent before Feb. 15, you may select 25% of the amount of your order—in free bulbs. Before March 15, you may select 20%, and before April 15, select 10%. This cannot be taken as a cash discount and does not apply to any special collection listed.

SPECIAL PREMIUM BULBS

If your order amounts to \$10.00 or over, during the season, I will include a root of **Indian Chief**, the new large Decorative valued at \$3.00. On \$5.00 orders, I will include a root of **Coral Beauty**, the new Miniature Decorative valued at 50c. These roots are in addition to your free premium bulbs.
