Anchusa Myosotidiflora

Chinese Forget-me-not. Beautiful shade of blue, for shade or sun. .20 each, \$2.00 per doz.

Aquilegia

Columbine, separate shades, blue, pink, white .15 each

Asters

Aster Novae Anglae—Adorable

A remarkable new aster, deep clear pink—a rare shade in Fall flowers. Height 4 to 4½ feet. September to frost. .50 each

Aster Novae Belgae—Beechwood Charm

Tinted deep rose-red, compact growth, medium height. September to frost. .50 each

Aster Novae Belgae—Blue Gown

China-blue, large flowered, tall growing, pyramidal. September to frost. .60 each

Aster Frikarti—Wonder of Staefa

Light lavender-blue with prominent yellow disk. Flowers 3 inches across and perfect for cutting. 2½ feet tall. August to frost. .50 each

Delphinium Belladonna

Clear sky-blue. .20 each

Dianthus Plumarius

The old-fashioned garden Clove Pink, mixed. .15 each

Digitalis

Foxglove. White or purple. .15 each

Gypsophila

Baby's Breath. Bristol Fairy, large panicles of double, white flowers all Summer. .50 each

Gypsophila Rosy Veil

Pink Flowering Baby's Breath. .25 each

Heuchera—Coral Bells

Queen of Hearts. Deep red in color with much larger bells than other varieties. Late Spring to July. .50 each

Iberis Sempervirens

Hardy Candytuft. .15 each

Phlox

Miss Lingard: White with pink center. **Von Hockberg:** brilliant red. **Rokoko:** clear soft pink. All Phlox .20 each

Primula Veris

Cowslip: mixed. .15 each

Primula Veris Colosus

A giant flowered variety in a great range of colors. Many flowers over two inches across. .35 each, 3 for \$1.00

Pyrethrum—Painted Daisy

Pink Bouquet—a perfect double Painted Daisy with flowers 4 inches across born 5 to 8 on a stem. Flowers larger and in greater quantity than any other variety. .50 each, 3 for \$1.25
